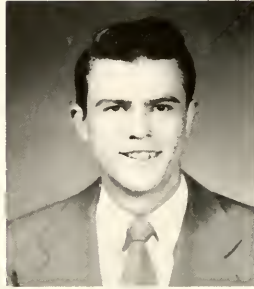
## ZETA ALPHA SIGMA

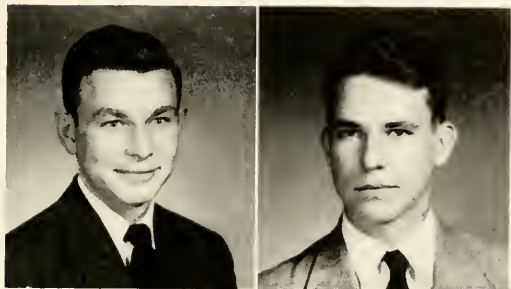

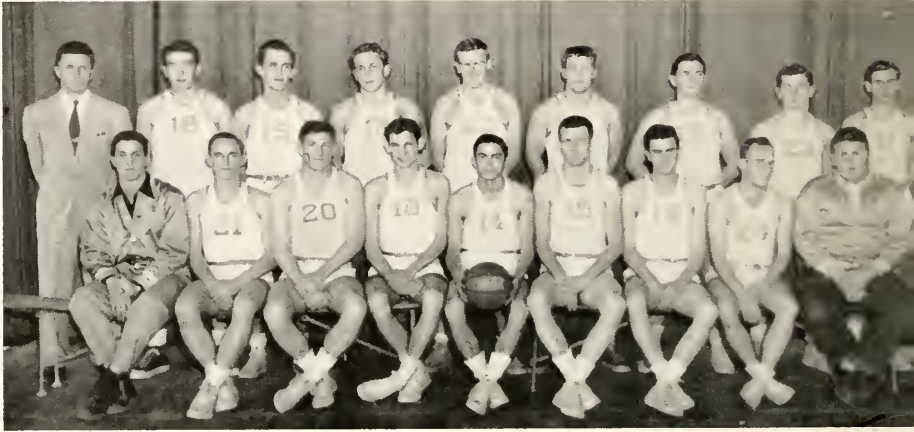

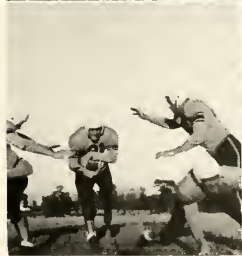
