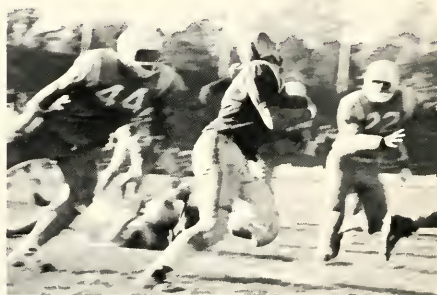
Braves Sneak by Gardner Webb

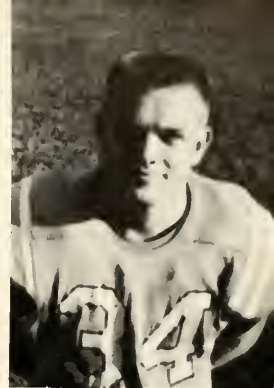

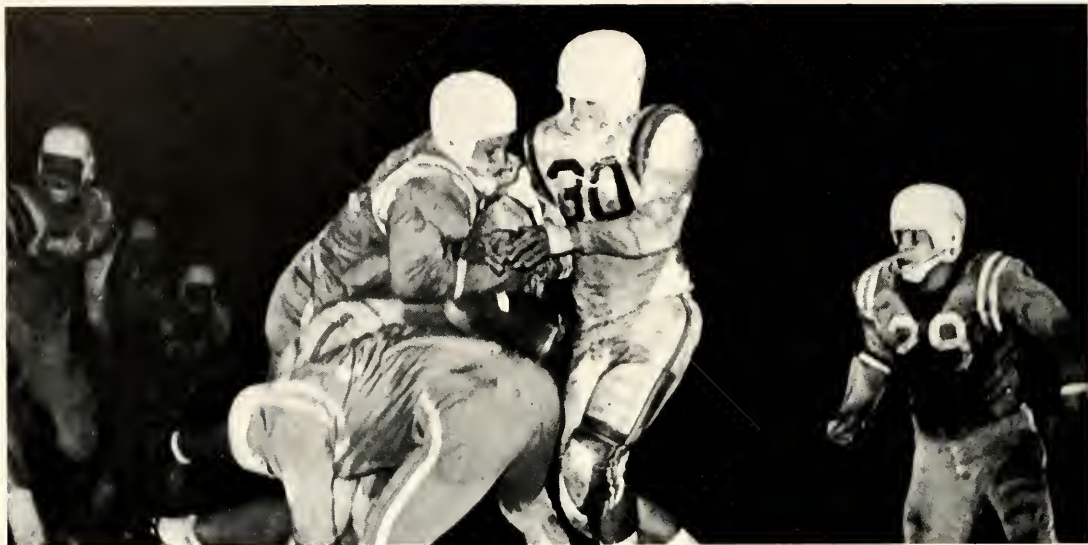

Ferrum Slips By Chowan

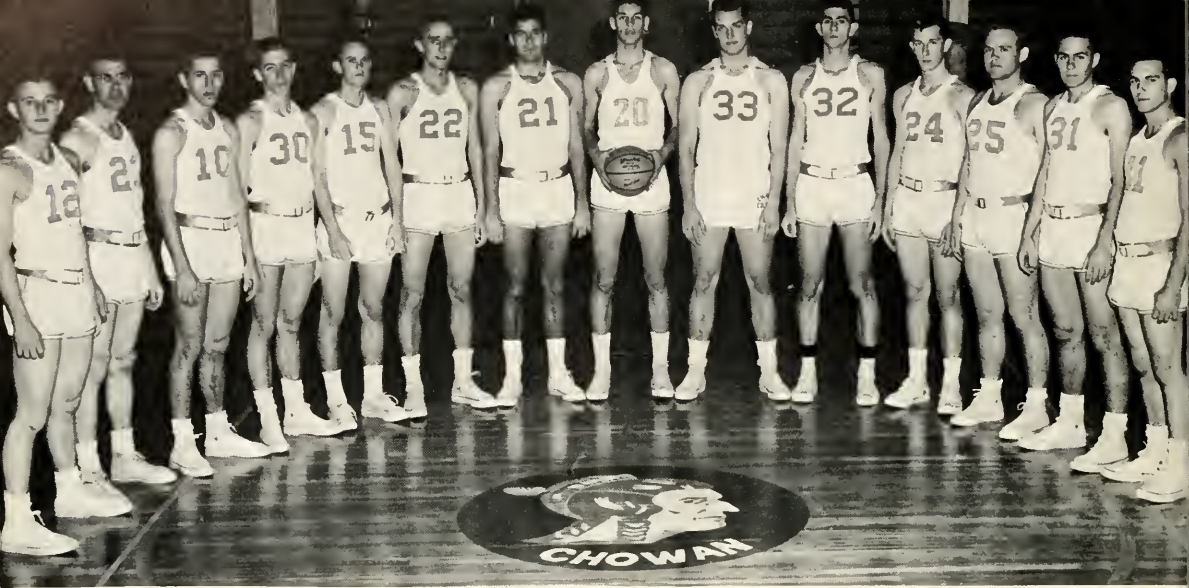
The Ferrum Panthers ended Chowan's 10-Game winning streak, including two ties, on a rain-soaked field at South Hill, Va.

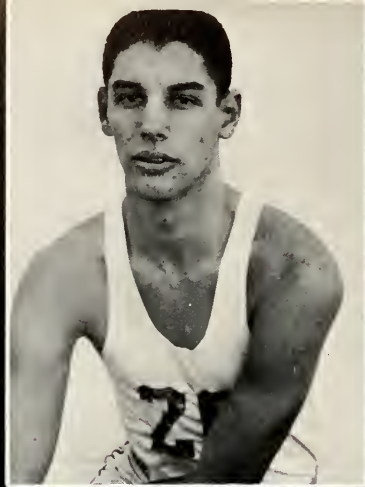

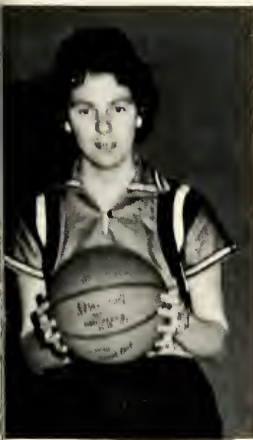
