After much hard work and a great deal of fun we completed an exciting high school career.

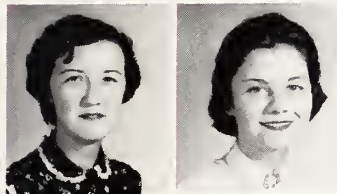
