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REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPRING QUARTER, 1967

I. Registration Dates

February 23 -- Packets will be distributed in the lobby of White Hall from 8 A.M. - 12 Noon and 1 P.M. through 5 P.M.

Students may pick up a Registration Permit while in the lobby of White Hall.

For example, seniors and graduate students may pick up Registration Permits for February 28 which would not conflict with classes for the following hours:

8 - 9, 9 - 10, 10 - 11, 11 - 12, 1 - 2, 2 - 3, 3 - 4, 4 - 5

Permit holders for a given hour, beginning with the number 1, will be admitted first. In the event a student is not present when his permit number comes up, he may get in line and will be admitted after other permit holders.

February 23 - 28 Students will secure Registration Approval Forms from advisors Registration Center in Lovill Hall

February 28 -- Registration of seniors and graduate students (8 A.M. - 3 P.M.)

Registration of juniors and special students (3 P.M. - 5 P.M.)

March 1 ----- Registration of juniors and special students (8 A.M. - 2 P.M.)

Registration of sophomores (2 P.M. - 5 P.M.)

March 2 ----- Registration of sophomores (8 A.M. - 2 P.M.)

Registration of freshmen (2 P.M. - 5 P.M.)

March 3 ----- Registration of freshmen (8 A.M. - 2 P.M.)

Late Comers (2 P.M. - 5 P.M.)

March 13 - 17 Payment of Fees

Registration may be completed by paying fees in the Student Recreation Area of the Cafeteria Building. Mealbooks will be issued as fees are paid. All accounts for Winter Quarter must be paid before students will be permitted to complete registration for Spring Quarter by paying fees or making arrangements.

Textbooks can be secured at bookstore by presenting receipt and turning in Winter Quarter books.

March 22 ----- Registration and Payment of fees for students not on campus Winter Quarter

Registration - Lovill Hall

Distribution of packets to new and returning students - Lovill Hall

Payment of fees - Cashier's Office, Room 112, White Hall

- March 22 Students on Academic Probation must report to the Office of the Dean of Student Affairs for instructions to complete registration.
- March 23 Late registration fee begins
- A student who does not complete his registration on March 22 will be charged a \$5.00 fee, with an increase of \$1.00 for each additional late day of registration, the total not to exceed \$10.00.
- March 29 Deadline for adding a course -- Registration closes
- April 12 Deadline for dropping a course without indicating passing or failing.

II. Vital Registration Information

1. Graduate students who plan to register for undergraduate courses should go to Checkers for instructions.
2. Any undergraduate student who forgets to bring or loses his packet must get permission from the Office of the Dean of Student Affairs before going to the Computer Center to secure a packet. Graduate students must secure permission from the Graduate Office. The Computer Center is located in Smith-Wright Hall, Room 112.
3. Women who have married and whose packets are under their maiden names should go to the Records Room before registering for Spring Quarter.
4. Undergraduate students expecting to complete degree requirements at the end of Spring Quarter must file an application for degree and certification during the registration period, or on registration day, March 22.
5. Undergraduates may not register for more than 19 hours without written permission from the Registrar. Graduate students may not register for more than 15 hours.

III. Instructions for Filling out Materials in Packet.

1. Fill in requested information on Student Master Card. It is not necessary to write anything on any course card secured.
2. Please fill in all blanks on the Student Information Card and Locator Card.
3. Follow the directions printed on the Library Card.
4. Fill in the top part of all copies of the Program Card. On the paper copy of the program card, the student should enter the department and course numbers desired.
5. Fill in the left hand portion of the Fee Card with a ballpoint pen.
6. For new or returning male students - Draft Card - Fill in Selective Service Number and complete address of Local Board. Do not fill in any other blanks.

ALL ITEMS LISTED ABOVE SHOULD BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO ENTERING THE REGISTRATION CENTER IN LOVILL HALL

IV. Completion of Registration

1. When you obtain a course card for each course section in which you wish to enroll, fill in the bottom of your program cards.
2. Be sure you have completed all forms properly before giving your packet to the checker.
3. Persons in the checking line will retain all of the cards except the paper copy of the program card. Present it and your receipt at the College Bookstore to obtain textbooks.
4. Registration is completed by paying fees or making arrangements with the Budget Officer in the Recreation Area of the Cafeteria Building. If fees are not paid or arrangements made by March 29, all cards will be pulled because the student is not officially registered.

V. Registration Procedures

- Step 1. Registration begins with the student's advisor. The student must secure from his advisor a Registration Approval Form. This form has a place for the advisor to list courses approved for Spring Quarter. The student will select the section number for the courses listed and fill in the remainder of the form.
- Step 2. The student will take his Registration Approval Form to the Registration Center. All course cards will be picked up from the Registration Center on presentation of this Registration Approval Form except course cards for sequence courses which were issued in classes and applied music cards which will be picked up at the Department of Music. Registration Center will be in the lobby of Lovill Hall.
- Step 3. After the course cards are secured, the registration packet and course cards will be checked and collected by checkers.
- Step 4. Payment of fees and securing mealbooks and textbooks.

VI. Drop-Add Procedure

To add a course, a student has to secure permission and the drop-add form from his advisor. The drop-add form is taken to the Registrar's Office to pick up a new course card and Class Admission Card. The Class Admission Card must be taken to the instructor of the class added before the student will be admitted to class.

To drop courses, the student must get the approval of his advisor. (A drop-add form is obtained from the student's advisor.) The student must secure the Class Admission Card from the instructor involved and take it and the drop-add form to the Office of the Registrar.

APPLIED MUSIC COURSES

All students taking applied music courses must have these courses approved by Dr. Spencer. After Dr. Spencer indicates approval on the Registration Form, course cards will be issued by the Music Department.

RESIDENCE STATUS FOR TUITION PAYMENT

The tuition charge for legal residents of North Carolina is less than for nonresidents. A legal resident of North Carolina is one who has his domicile in this State. It is important that each applicant for admission and each enrolled student know his residence status for tuition payment and understand the regulations governing residence status. The following regulations cover most factual situations:

1. A person twenty-one years of age or older is not deemed eligible for the lower tuition rate unless he has maintained his legal residence in North Carolina for at least the six months next preceding the date of his first enrollment in an institution of higher education in this State.

2. The legal residence of a person under twenty-one years of age at the time of his first enrollment in an institution of higher education in this State is that of his parents, surviving parent, or legal guardian. In cases where parents are divorced or legally separated, the legal residence of the father will control unless custody of the minor has been awarded by court order to the mother or to a legal guardian other than a parent. No claim of residence in North Carolina will be considered if either parent is still living unless the action of the court appointing the guardian antedates the student's first enrollment in a North Carolina institution of higher education by at least twelve months.

3. The residence status of any student is determined as of the time of his first enrollment in an institution of higher education in North Carolina and may not thereafter be changed except: (a) in the case of a nonresident minor student at the time of his first enrollment whose parents have subsequently established legal residence in North Carolina; and (b) in the case of a residence who abandons his legal residence in North Carolina. In either case, the appropriate tuition rate will become effective at the beginning of the semester or term next following the date of change of residence status.

4. The legal residence of a wife follows that of her husband, except that a woman student currently enrolled in this institution as a resident may continue as a student even though she marries a nonresident.

5. Military personnel attached to military posts or reservations in North Carolina are not considered eligible for the lower tuition rate unless they have maintained a legal residence in the state for at least the six months next preceding the date of first enrollment in an institution of higher education in the state.

6. Aliens lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence who have established a legal residence in North Carolina according to Paragraphs number 1, 2, or 4, above, are eligible for the lower tuition rate.

7. Ownership of property in or payment of taxes to the State of North Carolina apart from legal residence will not qualify one for the lower tuition rate.

8. Discretion to adjust individual cases within the spirit of these regulations is lodged in the Director of Business Affairs and Registrar.

Any student or prospective student in doubt concerning his residence status must bear the responsibility for securing a ruling by stating his case in writing to the Director of Business Affairs and Registrar.

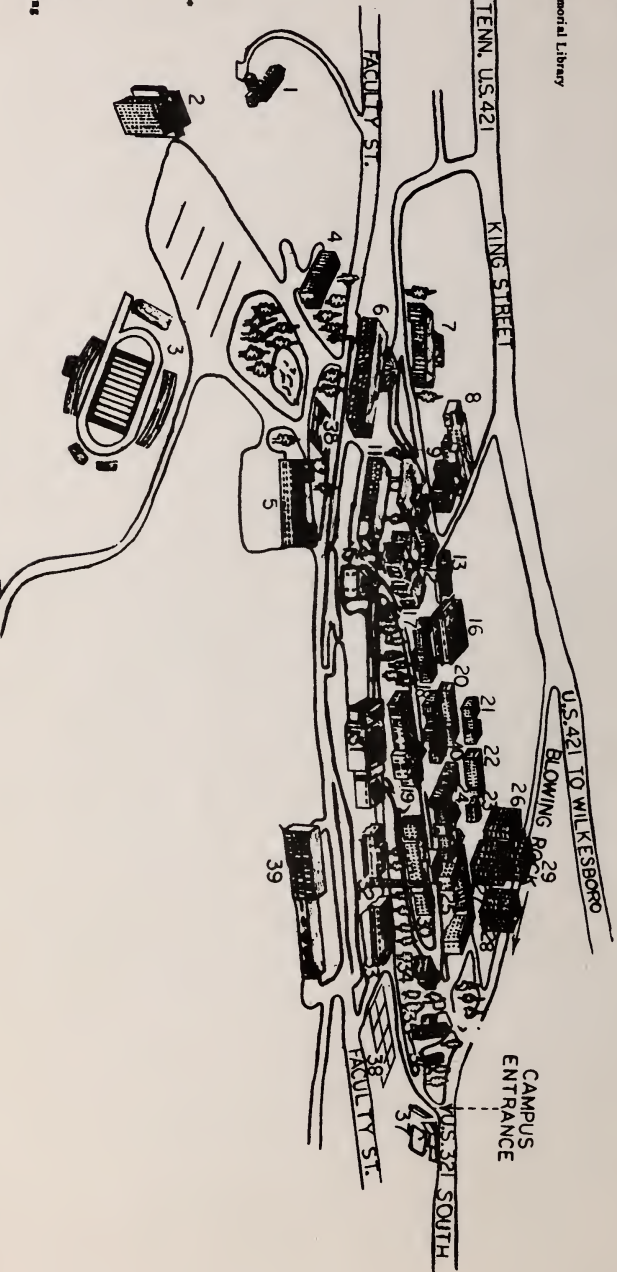
