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REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FALL QUARTER 1964-65

I. DISTRIBUTION OF REGISTRATION PACKETS

New Freshmen. Freshmen entering Appalachian for the first time in the summer or fall, 1964, will receive registration packets and instructions during the conference period with faculty advisers on Thursday, September 10.

New Transfer Students (Undergraduate). Undergraduate transfer students entering Appalachian will receive registration packets and instructions during orientation with faculty advisers on Wednesday, September 9.

Student Teachers. Fall quarter student teachers will receive registration packets and instructions at a group meeting at 9:30 on Thursday, September 10, in the Elementary School auditorium.

Returning Undergraduate, Graduate, and New Graduate Students. Returning students and new graduate students will receive their registration packets and instructions by mail. (Graduate students who plan to register for undergraduate courses should go to the Computer Center for registration instructions.) Any student who forgets to bring his packet on registration day, or did not receive one by mail, must get permission from the Office of the Dean of Student Affairs before going to the Computer Center to secure a packet. The Computer Center is located in the Old Science Building, Room 108.

Women who have married, and whose packets are under their maiden names, should go to the Records Room before registering for the fall quarter.

Undergraduate students expecting to complete degree requirements at the end of the Fall Quarter must file Applications for degree and certificate by 5 P. M. Registration Day, Thursday, September 10.

Freshmen who entered last year should see their advisers to obtain Student Progress Report sheets before registering.

III. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT MATERIALS IN PACKET

1. It is not necessary to write anything on the Student Master Card or any course card secured.
2. Please fill in all blanks on the Student Information Card and Alumni Card.

3. Follow the directions printed on the Motor Vehicle Card and Library Card.
4. Fill in the top part of all copies of the Program Card. On the paper copy of the program card, the student should enter the departments and course numbers desired.
5. Fill in the left hand portion of the Fee Card with a ballpoint pen.
6. Fill in all information on Draft Cards.

All of the items listed above should be completed prior to Registration Day.

IV. REGISTRATION SCHEDULES

All students will follow the schedule listed below in picking up course cards, consulting with advisers and department chairmen, and paying fees on their respective dates. These registration dates are:

V. COMPLETION OF PROGRAM CARD AND SECURING COURSE CARDS IN HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION BUILDING

1. Get your adviser to assist and approve your selection of courses on your Program Card (paper copy).
2. Undergraduates may not register for more than 19 hours without written permission from the Registrar. Graduate students may not register for more than 15 hours.
3. Present the paper copy of your program card to the teachers on duty and ask for your course card by section numbers as given in Registration Instructions and Class Schedule for Fall Quarter, 1964-65. Be sure the course card which the teacher hands you agrees with the department, course number, and section as it is entered on your program card.
4. When you have obtained a course card for each course section in which you wish to enroll, fill in the bottom of your program cards and go to the Men's Old Gym for payment of fees.

VI. FINAL CHECKING AND PAYMENT OF FEES

1. Be sure you have completed all forms properly before giving your packet to the checker.
2. Persons in the paying line will retain all of the cards except the library card and the paper copy of the program card. Present the latter at the College Bookstore to obtain textbooks, and present it to the teacher at the first class meeting of each section in which you enroll. Take the library card to the library on your first visit.
