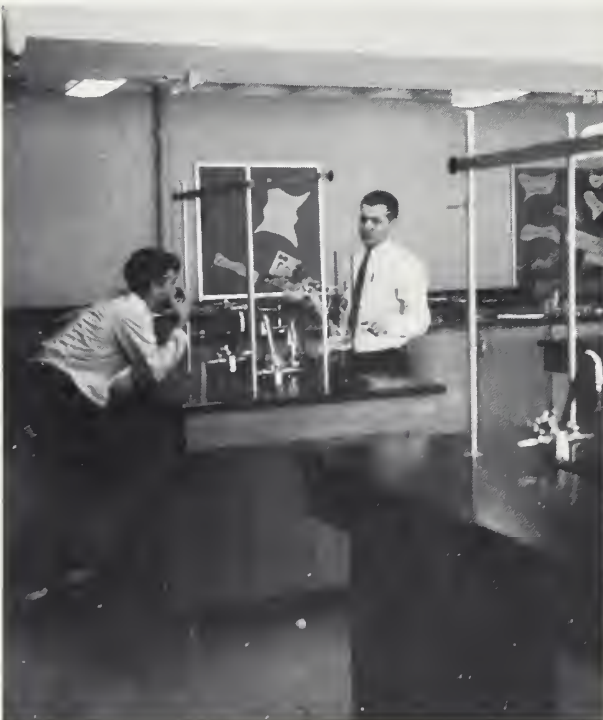

Experimentation usually results in understanding.

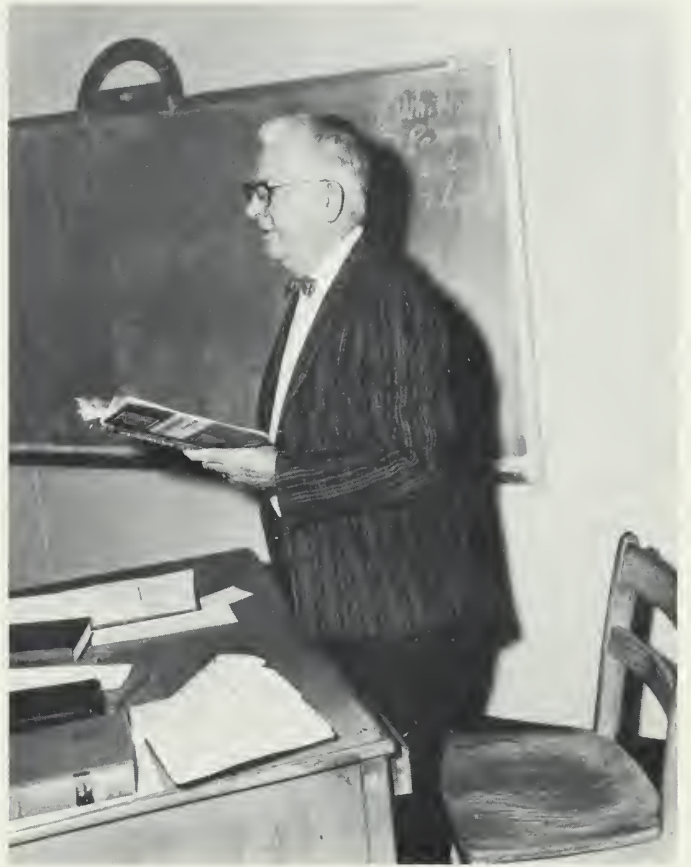
