# History

By the end of the year we felt we were really a part of the High School.

The first things we noticed when next we met, in the fall of '56, was that we still had twenty-five members and again had Mr. Robison as our advisor. When we returned as juniors, we were very much aware of the responsibility placed upon our shoulders. The chief things accomplished were the class play, publication of THE CLEVANA, and preparation for graduation. We never knew we could work so hard and yet have so much fun in the process.

The Junior-Senior was an event that we shall always remember. It was wonderful to be honored in this way.

Graduation was upon us before we knew it. This history ends when we receive our diplomas. Our hopes and ambitions are high as we stand with our faces to the future. We hope that each individual in the class will be able to fit himself into some place of service and usefulness in life. We realize at this commencement time that life has just begun for us and that it is time to grasp all opportunities and to rise to greater and better things.
