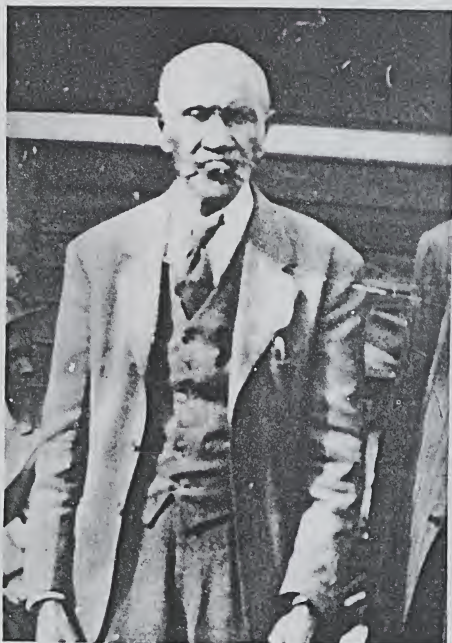

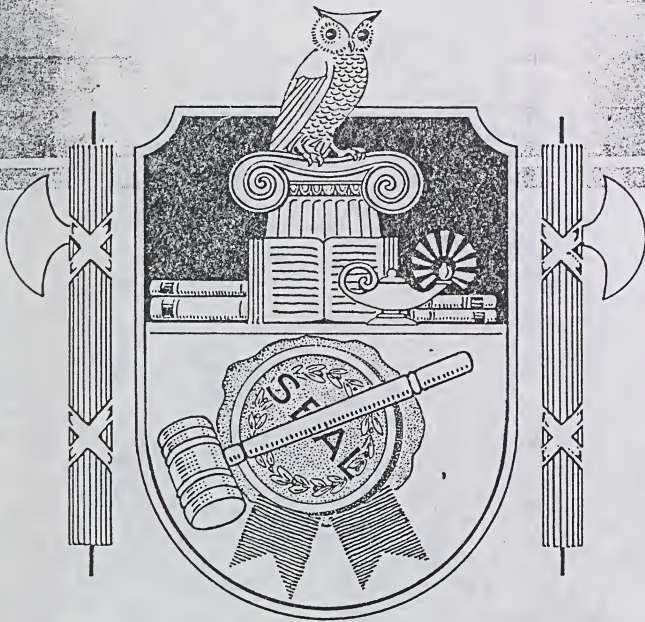

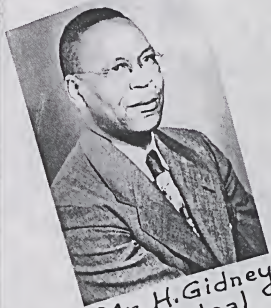
He married Miss Bettye Watkins of South Carolina. Eleven children were born to this couple, nine of which still live.

College.
