




J.W. Watkins affectionately called "Father watkins", a citizen of Boiling Springs, N.C. was born in 1870 of slave parents in the state of South Carolina.


One of the first accomplishments was that of Roscoe Lowe's winning first place in the District Contest. The Shop Contest consisted of two phases:identification of all the most common hand tools found in a modern school work shop and that of cutting rafters and stringers for doorsteps. Hoscoe also wrote an essay which fully explained how his school work shop had helped him with his supervised farming program.

This makes the third time that the contest has been won by an agricultural student from Green Bethel High School.

In order to fully co-operate with the county and state in their reforestation program, the students studying vocational agriculture, along with a few adult farmers ordered and set our 19,500 pine seedlings in anuary, 1952. Mr. Jones, a trainee from A.& T. College, who was doing his practice work here assisted in this program.

The officers of the N.F.A. Chapter wish to thank members of the faculty and all of their friends for co-operating so nicely in the Colored Orphanage Drive of Oxford, N.C.. Through this combined effort, the Agr. students raised and donated \$100.00 to the Colored Orphanage. James A. Martin, President of the N.F.A. raised \$20.33, James Marl collected \$22.50, and Warren Montgomery, Sec. of the N.F.A. collected \$16.50. Each contestant and donator won a free trip to A.& T. College.

The 10th, 11th, and 12th graders initiated 9th graders into the N.F.A. Chapter. A social followed, and members of the faculty, N.H.A. girls, and other guest were invited. Mrs. DeVane and her N.H.A. girls served refreshments.






