## COWPEAS

Now that the advantages of legumes are getting to be so well known, we think it advisable to offer seed to our customers. As is well known, the growing of trees is hard on land. This is true to such an extent that we have to rest our land for a couple of years after growing a crop or two of trees on it. We find that nothing will so quickly restore vitality and fertility as cowpeas. We plant them between seedlings and put them in at every opportunity we get.

Every planter of an orchard ought to make use of some legume to fill his soil full of nitrogen for the use of his trees. Almost always, cowpeas will be the best legume to be found. They can be put in among other crops, the tops harvested or turned under. As a cover crop, mixed with some oats, they are fine.
