SHIPPED, in apparent good order and condition, by RIRINSHO KAGI
 on board the ship HAKUSAN-MARU (Voy. No. 36-OUT, for the Company's reference) under
 Japanese flag, commanded by S. TAKAHATA for the present voyage or whomsoever else may be placed in command;
 in or off the port of KEELUNG and bound for SINGAPORE
 with liberty to deviate for the purpose of saving life or property, to call at any port or ports in or out of the customary or advertised route, in any order,
 for the purpose of discharging and receiving goods and passengers, dry docking with or without cargo on board if thought necessary or convenient, or taking
 in coal and other necessary supplies at any such port or ports, or for any other purpose whatsoever, to sail without pilots, and to tow and assist vessels in
 distress; the following goods being marked and numbered as indicated below, and to be delivered from the ship's deck where the ship's responsibility shall cease,
 at the port of SINGAPORE or so near thereto as the ship
 may safely get, unto BELEY GARDEN, SIKEMIT SINGAPORE or his or their assigns, subject to
 conditions and exceptions enumerated hereon and on the back hereof. Freight and primage (if any) to be paid by the shippers in advance, on delivery of
 the Bill of Lading, in cash without discount, or at destination by the consignees as may be agreed upon and declared below. Freight and primage
 (if any) to be considered as earned whether the ship or the goods be lost or not lost at any stage of the entire transit.
