## DEDICATION



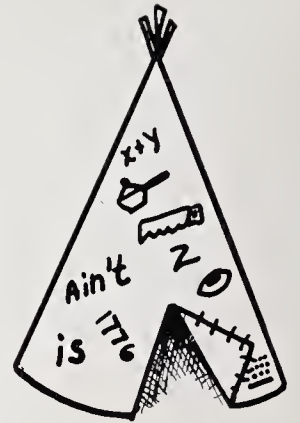

## REUNION IN 1962

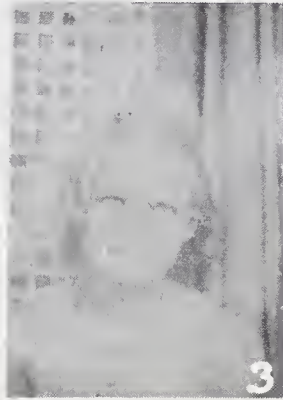
