Jimmy Roberson was always good for staying out of trouble, and now he is trying to help others stay out of trouble, too. He is Chief of Police in his old home town.


Last but not least, I see the last member of my class. It's Thomas Smiley. He is running his own service station. I guess he really enjoys that if he works on nothing but Fords.
