

Data for Itinerary.

First Mapping Expedition to Basilan.

(January 26 to February 4, 1906.)

January 26, 1906. - Left Zamboanga at 8 a.m. on a small ~~steam~~ launch and steamed to Isabella, Basilan Island, carrying a mapping expedition, commanded by Captain Halstead Dorey, with a Lieutenant <sup>who established Camp No. 1.</sup> and 15 enlisted men.

January 27, 1906. - Remained in Camp <sup>No. 1,</sup> mapping trails in the vicinity of Isabella.

January 28, 1906. - Left Isabella at 7:18 a.m. and marched 2 miles to Mr. Henry Musser's ranch and Camp No. 2, <sup>just by along the sea beach.</sup>

January 29, 1906. - Left Camp No. 2 at 6:30 a.m., and marched to Camp No. 3 <sup>(about 2 miles).</sup>

January 30, 1906. - Left Camp No. 3 and reached Camp <sup>No. 4</sup> ~~No. 4~~ at a shallow well near the ocean where General Bliss, Captain Dorey and myself afterwards landed from steamboat and shot ducks.

January 31, 1906. - Camp No. 4 to Camp No. 5 (Dorey's old camp, near the ocean).

February 1, 1906. - Camp No. 5 to Camp No. 6, south towards the highest mountain of the interior. Camp on stream.

February 2, 1906. - Camp No. 6 to Camp No. 7, near ~~Tipu Tipu~~ Tipu Tipu.

February 3, 1906. - Camp No. 7 to Camp No. 8. To stream off the mountain, one of Dorey's old camp sites.

February 4, 1906. - Camp No. 8 to Camp No. 9, at La Mitán, where we lunched <sup>at the house of Deputy Governor J. M. Brown</sup> and then proceeded to Zamboanga, Mindanao.

Left Basilan afternoon of Feb. 4, 1906, and arrived at Zamboanga the same night.

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Probably at Zamboanga from February 4 to 11, 1906, as I skinned a pigeon shot by a soldier near Zambo. on the 5th. Am certain I was in Zamboanga Feb. 11, 1906.

Second Mapping Expedition to Basilan.

(February 13 to 22, 1906.)

Feb. 13, 1906. — An early start from Zamboanga, by steam launch to Isabella, Basilan, enabled us to make our first camp on the <sup>Some collections were made at the falls of the Aguada Grande River</sup> Libuk River, Basilan, Camp No. 1.

February 14, 1906. — Crossed the Kumalarang River.

Camp No. 2

February 15, 1906. — Left Camp No. 2 and marched to ~~About noon passed Boje Sayas, where a colony of Kahgwangs was found; then proceeded to~~. Thence proceeded to Tipu-Tipu. Camp No. 3.

February 16, 1906. — Left camp on the (Sangiang?) River, near Tipu-Tipu, Basilan Island <sup>about 7 A.M.</sup> and marched <sup>the south side of Basilan, then west to</sup> to the Buli-Buli River, crossing Camaling and <sup>Jumahobang rivers to</sup> Camp No. 4.

February 17, 1906. — Marched from Camp No. 4, on the Buli-Buli River to <sup>Jumahobang River</sup> crossed the Libuk River. Camp No. 5

February 18, 1906. — Camp 5 to Camp No. 6.

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February 19, 1906. — Camp 6 to Camp 7.

Left camp no. 6, on the

River at 7:10 A.M.

Marched to Malusa, and thence to

February 20, 1906. — Camp no. 7 to Camp no. 8.

February 21, 1906. Camp no. 8 to Camp no. 9,  
at Musser's plantation, near Isabella, Basilan

February 22, 1906. — Spent the forenoon  
in shooting at Mussers, then marched to Isabella  
and took the steam launch to Zamboanga
