Our next meeting will be held on 20th February at 12.30 p.m

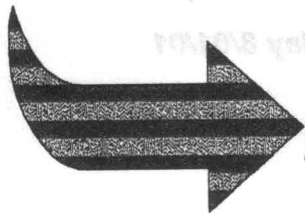

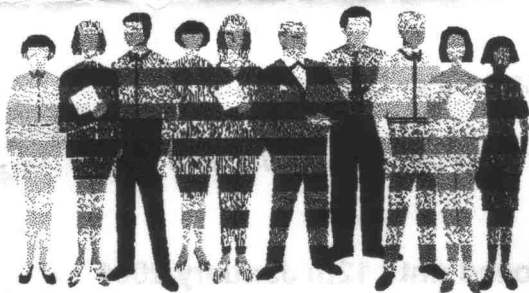
Merino Field Day Saturday 13 January 2001
