Greetings to Delungra residents. Add a little spice to your life - Cayenne. This popular plant is originally from South America and now is cultivated world wide. Its great for those cold winter evenings when you need to warm up.from the inside out!! Sauté one chopped onion in a little olive oil. Add 3 crushed garlic cloves. Add 500 grams of lean mince and lightly brown. Add 1/2 teas of chilli powder or some finely chopped fresh chillies. Next add a 400 gm tin of red kidney beans, 400 gm tin of chopped tomatoes. Combine and simmer 20 minutes. Serve with steamed rice and a green salad.
