Taming thrush infections - if you are bothered by thrush you may need to see your health care professional for some anti-yeast medication.

Lactobacillus acidophilus is a friendly bacteria that helps create a more normal bacterial environment - eating yoghurt is one way to improve your intake of friendly bacteria, though probaiotic supplements are a quicker was of getting useful amounts of the needed bacteria. Suggestions to discourage the overgrowth of an unfriendly bacteria.

(1) Go easy on the sweets, sugar favours the growth of yeast in the body.

(2) Do not sit around in a wet swimsuit as damp environment invites yeast proliferation.

(3) Wear cotton underwear which helps to keep you cool and dry.


Delungra Girl Guides
