Looking forward to a happy and fulfilling year!!!

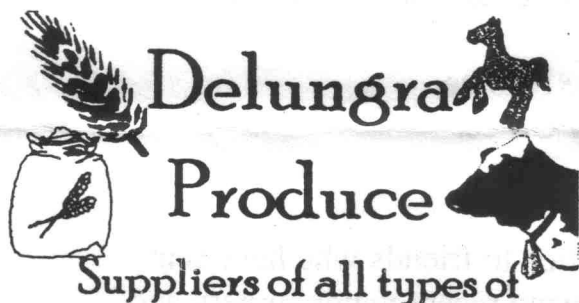
Personal Thank You
