Well our school term is already in full swing and we are only staring Week 3. We have had four new children enroll and we welcome them and their families.

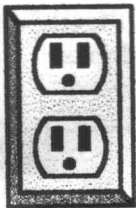

5. Built and Natural Development

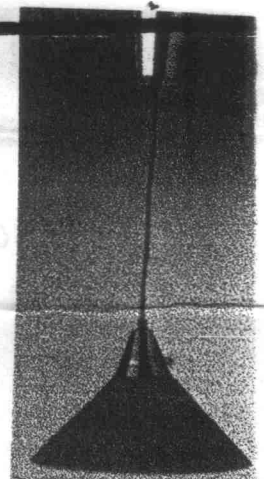
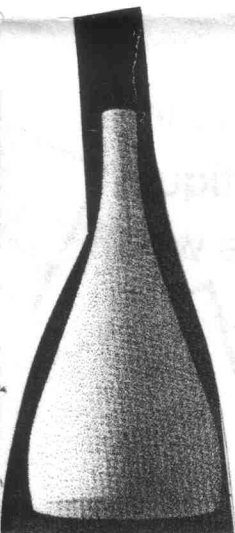

We thank Ann and Harry McNaughton for laying the lino in the kitchen cupboards and all those helpers who help in a voluntary capacity.

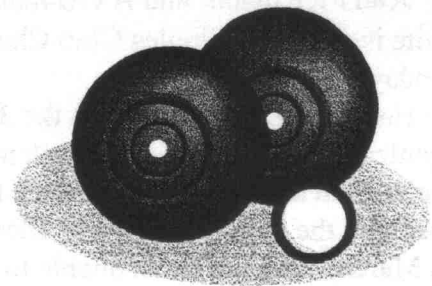

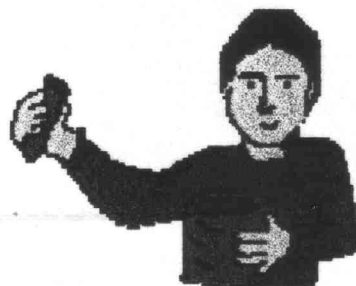

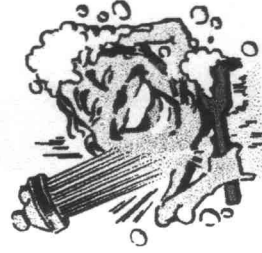
