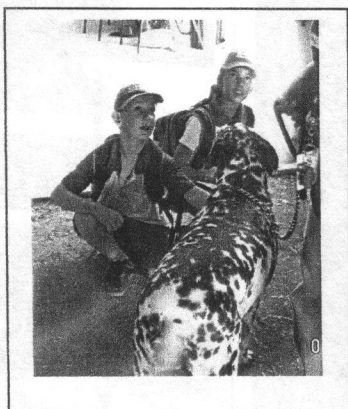
Delungra Public School News



Inverell Show Excursion.

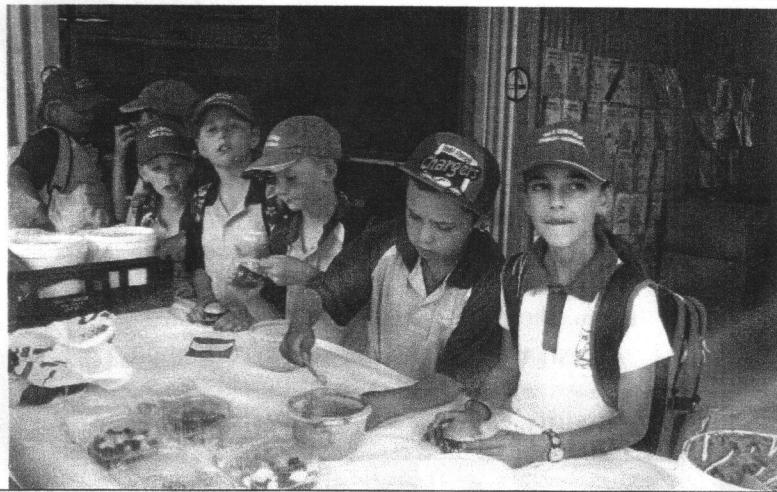

Delungra Community Mens Dinner

Commencing soon there will be a regular men's dinner held in Delungra. They will be usually held the last Saturday of the month however the first dinner will be scheduled for the 10th of March to avoid clashing with the Inverell show. Future meetings will be in April, June, August and October and will offer an informal evening for local men to get together and enjoy fellowship and friendship. The dinners will cater for all ages and it is hoped that there will be a good cross section of our community able to attend. Our welcome also extends to anyone who has previously lived in Delungra or who has a connection with our community.

In previous years Delungra's tennis club provided locals the opportunity to meet and socialise. Delungra Apex Club also played a very important and active role in our district bringing young men together for friendship and fellowship. Unfortunately these valuable organisations along with others no longer have a presence in our town. These dinners offer a venue for both our farming community and our local township residents to meet and socialise. There will be no agendas, elections or commitment expected of anyone. There will be a minimal charge of \$15.00 for the dinner. This should just cover the costs and make a small profit for the community group that assists in the kitchen. These will be short and of either an educational or humorous content. It will not be a platform for product promotion or religious or political agendas. The focus of the evenings will be to allow guests to enjoy each others company.

It is hoped that there will be many positive outcomes from these evenings.

- The catering will be offered to all community to groups to provide the dinners. This will give them the opportunity to raise some funds to support their organisation at a time when fundraising is becoming increasingly difficult.
- The bowling club will welcome the patronage and will certainly appreciate the increase bar sales.
- It will provide a friendly gathering for people who have recently moved into our district and are looking for place to meet the locals and find out more about our area.

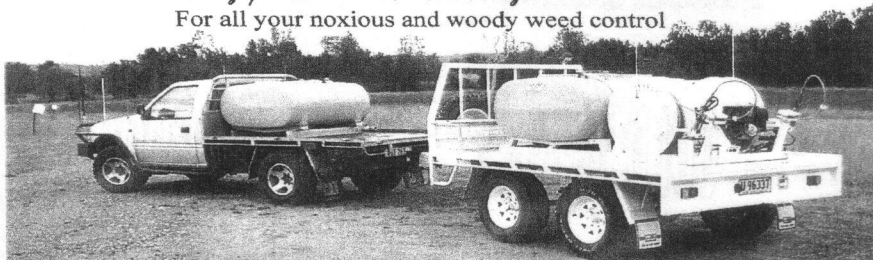

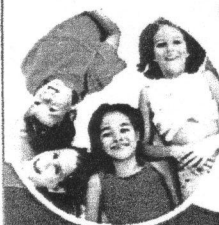
