I would like to bring to the attention of all residents delivering rubbish to the waste dept, please keep recyclable material separate from disposable nappies and rotting foodstuff.

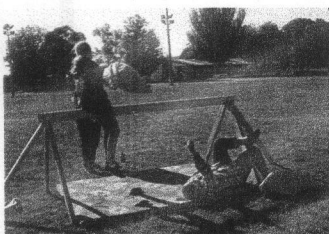
Whats Happening in Term 2

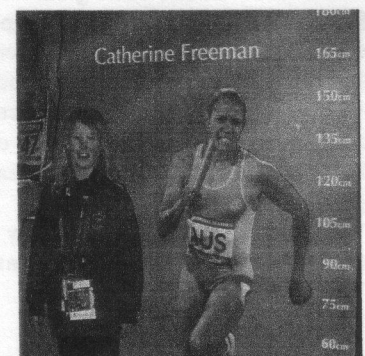

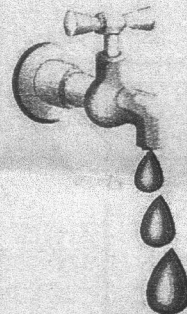

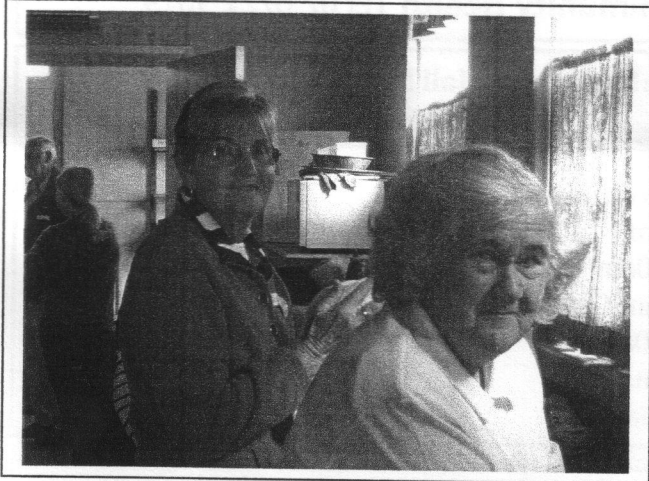
Delungra CWA's Biggest Morning Tea.
