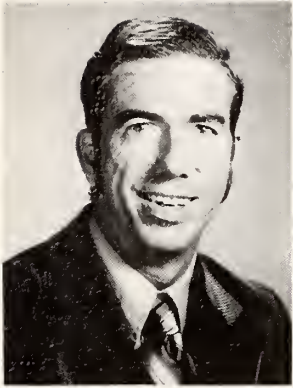


DEDICATION
