# Growth...







#### in facilities . .

Robeson Technical Institute began its life in 1965 in a classroom building and one metal shop on the Barker-Ten Mile Campus. Growth in curriculums and enrollment dictated expansion; in 1973, R.T.I. moved to a new building located north of Lumberton on 70 acres at the intersection of Highways 301 and I-95. The new brick structure of 48,000 square feet houses a library, offices, classrooms, laboratories, special skill areas, and a student lounge. Again R.T.I. has found its present facilities inadequate to house extra curriculums and a growing enrollment; therefore, contracts were awarded in December of 1974 for the construction of new buildings. Land behind the new building north of Lumberton was chosen for the site. Construction has begun on two buildings of approximately 30,000 square feet. which will house Nursing, business courses, a shop for Automotive Mechanics, Air-Conditioning and Refrigeration, Carpentry, and Masonry. These buildings should be ready for occupancy by 1976; even then both the old and new campuses will be needed to meet demands.









#### in programs . . .

#### Cosmetology

The Cosmetology Curriculum provides instruction and practice in manicuring, shampooing, permanent waving, facials, messages, scalp treatment, hair cutting, and styling. This Curriculum is approved by the North Carolina State Board of Cosmetic Art Examiners.











#### **Practical Nursing**

The Practical Nursing Curriculum is structured to prepare students for participating in the care of patients of all ages, in various states of dependency, and with a variety of illness conditions. Graduates of the program are eligible to take the licensing examination given by the North Carolina Board of Nursing.





#### Business

The Business Curriculum is designed to prepare the graduate for employment in many phases of business operation.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION: management trainee, salesman, supervisor.

ACCOUNTING: recording keeping, clerks, bookkeepers, assistant accountants.

GENERAL OFFICE TECHNOLOGY: administrative assistant, file clerk, machine transcriptionist, general clerical.

SECRETARIAL SCIENCE: stenographer, executive secretary.












#### Police Science


This curriculum provides academic training for law enforcement officers, prospective law enforcement officers, and citizens interested in the crime problem.

The student must develop a competency in investigative techniques, patrol and traffic mechanics of arrest, search, and seizure. In one year this curriculum's enrollment has increased to 80 students.

#### General Education

The Associate Degree General Education Program is a two-year program in which a student may complete all work toward an associate degree. Courses are those which are usually the entire requirement of the freshman and sophomore program in four-year colleges.







#### Developmental Studies

The Developmental Studies Curriculum is planned to provide developmental instruction in mathematics, English, and science to strengthen the student so that he may be better prepared to enter a vocational or technical curriculum.



#### Machinist

The machinist is a skilled metal worker who shapes metal parts by using machine tools and hand tools. His training and experience enable him to plan and carry through all the operations needed in turning out a machined product and to switch readily from one kind of product to another.



#### The Building Trades

CARPENTRY: farming, scaffolding, finishing, millwork, cabinetmaking.

MASONRY: bricklaying, cement masons, stone masons.

ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION: residential wiring, commercial wiring.




#### Welding








#### Automotive



When Robeson Technical Institute opened its doors at Barker Ten Mile on July 1, 1965, it had one goal: to fill the need for post-secondary training at the technical and vocational levels. In the beginning, the institute offered two fulltime curriculums with 21 students. It now offers 13 degree programs and 11 diploma programs. From the fall of 1973, to the fall of 1974, enrollment has risen from 636 to 1,018 students. Other programs offered at R.T.I. seek to provide cducational opportunities to adults for perfecting skills, for personal enrichment, and for improving basic cducation. During the 1973-1974 school year, 5,697 persons participated in some form of cducational programs. Fall quarter 1974-1975 alone showed an enrollment of 4,686. R.T.I. is expanding to meet the needs of its students by offering new courses of study and providing comfortable facilities.
