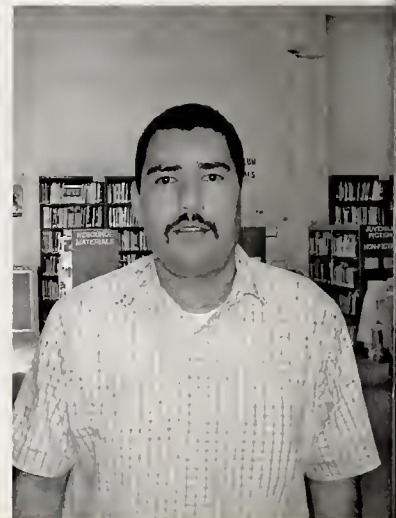
More Last Will and Testament

A closer look at Goldsboro Adult Degree Program

David Weil, current owner of the Goldsboro Adult Degree building, shared interesting information about the vault located in the lobby of the building:

"When I purchased the building the vault door was locked and no one living knew the combination. I hired a professional safe cracker who spent approximately three days "drilling" the door.

At the time when the vault was installed banks were interested in conveying the image of "safety and security" to their customers. Even though banks keep relatively little cash on hand, customers in those kinder and simpler times sometimes thought that their deposits and savings were actually kept at the bank, and the bank used those massive doors to drive home the image of "safety". The vault was part of the image that the bank wished to convey."

The vault is now used to house faculty and staff mail boxes for the Goldsboro campus.

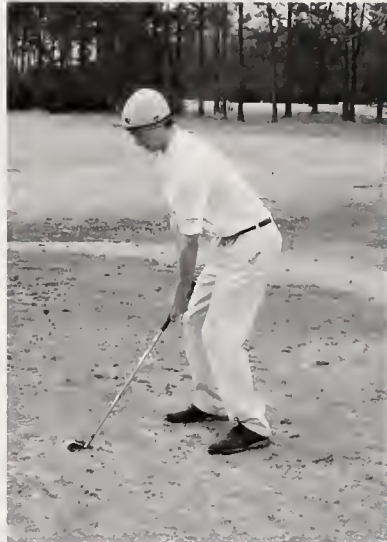

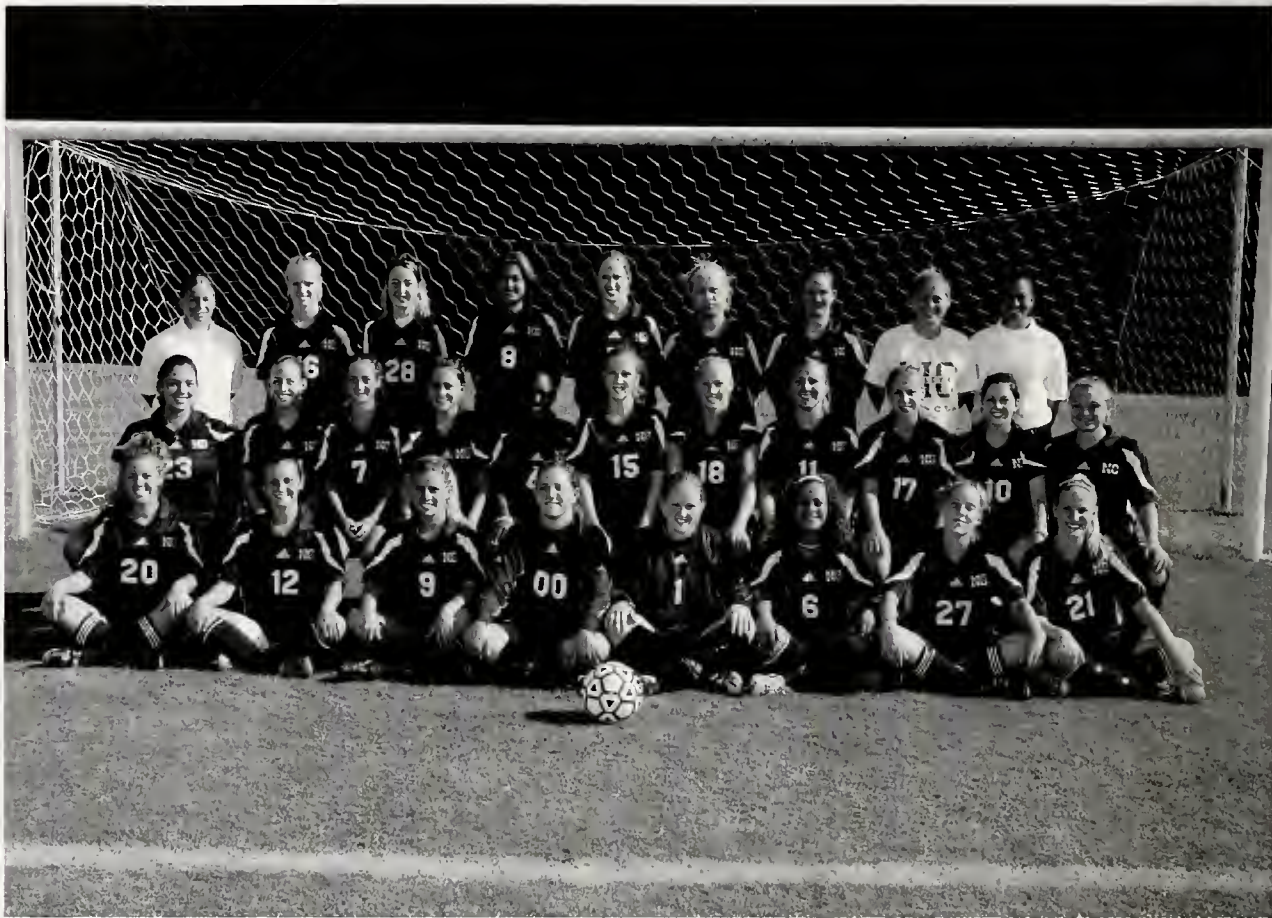

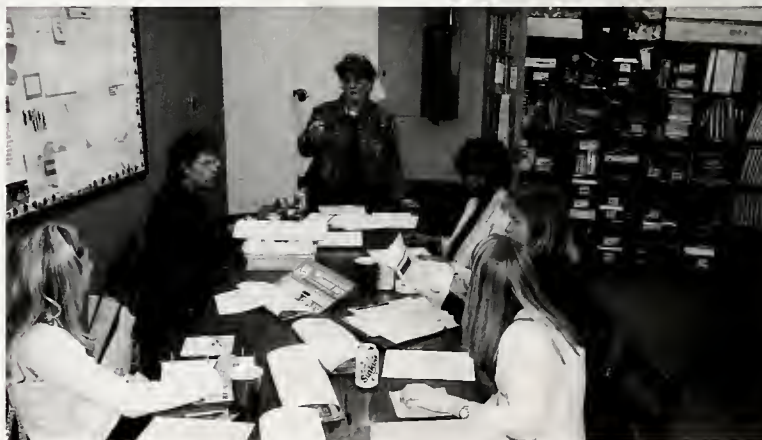
