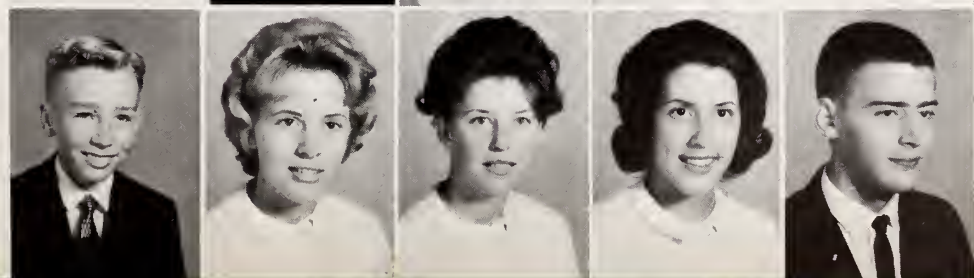
This is the Beta Convention?
