Dorsal fin same as side of body

at base  
Anal fin same as the dorsal  
Neutral fin same as dorsal  
Tail and top of head that brown

Colors

Same as the Volcan Walla  
except that the anal fin  
more pointed and longer  
Back fin same as  
dorsal fin  
belly and sides pale white  
gill cover gold and bronze

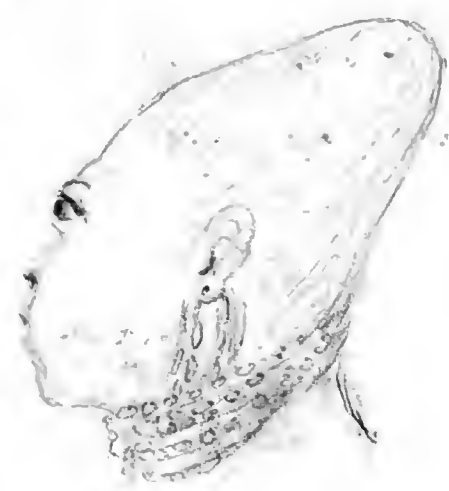

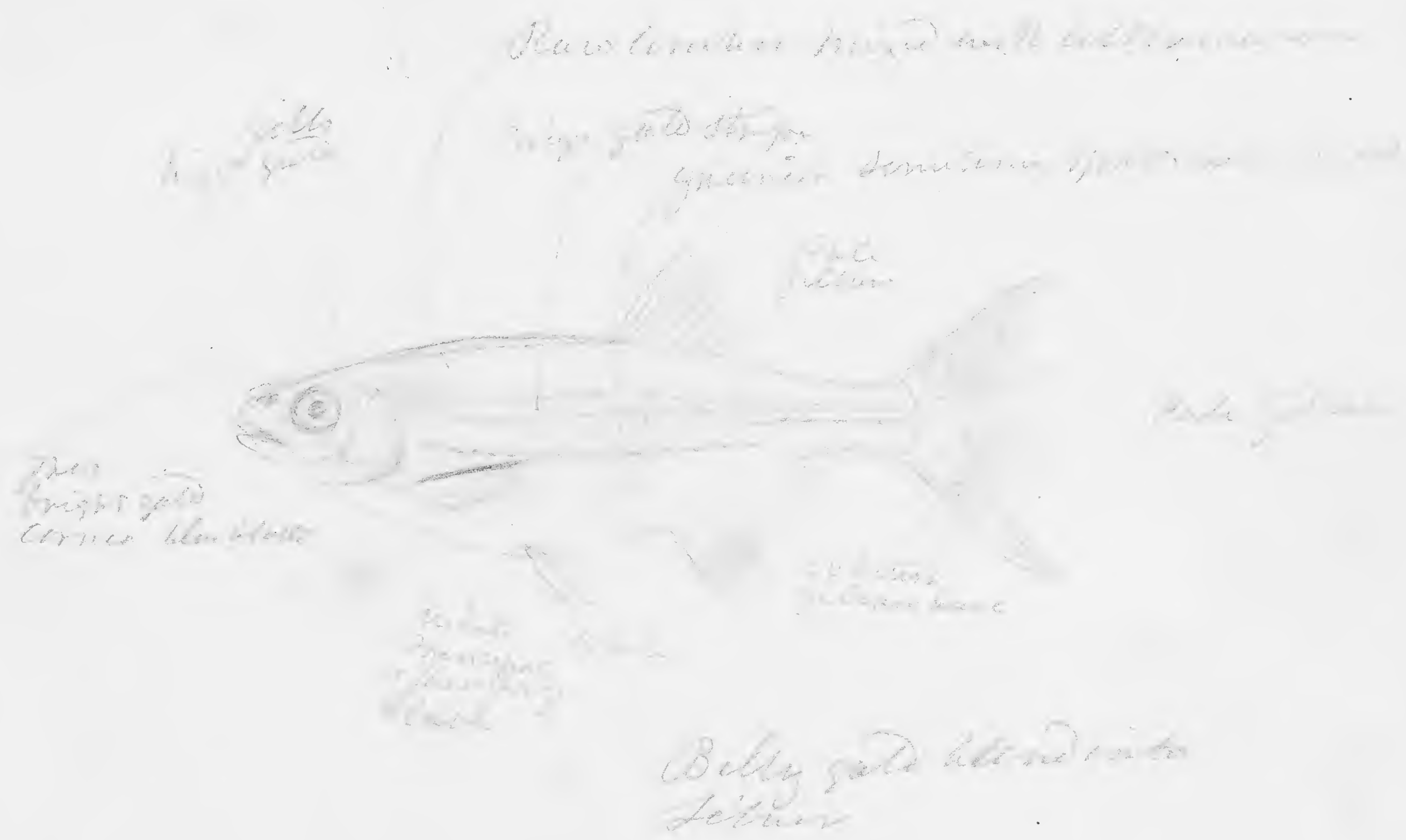


This is a general sketch

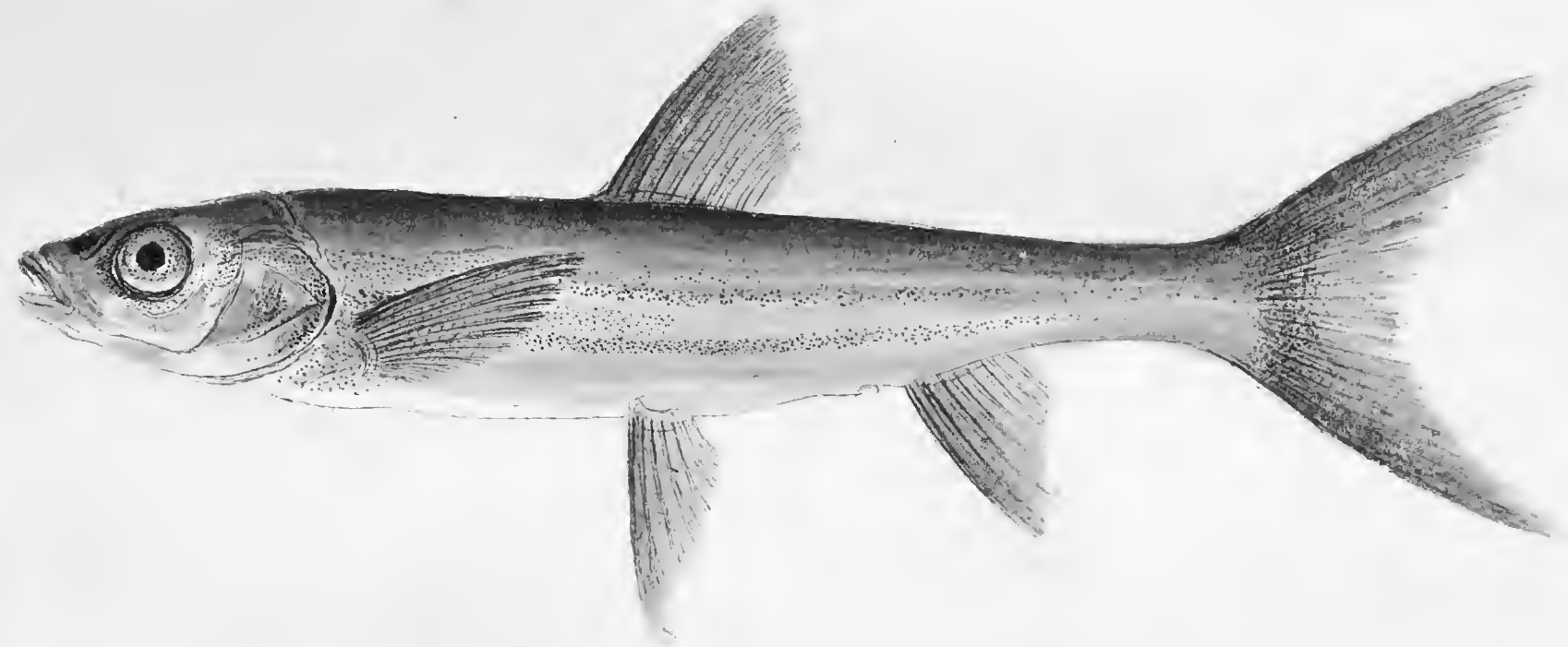
