

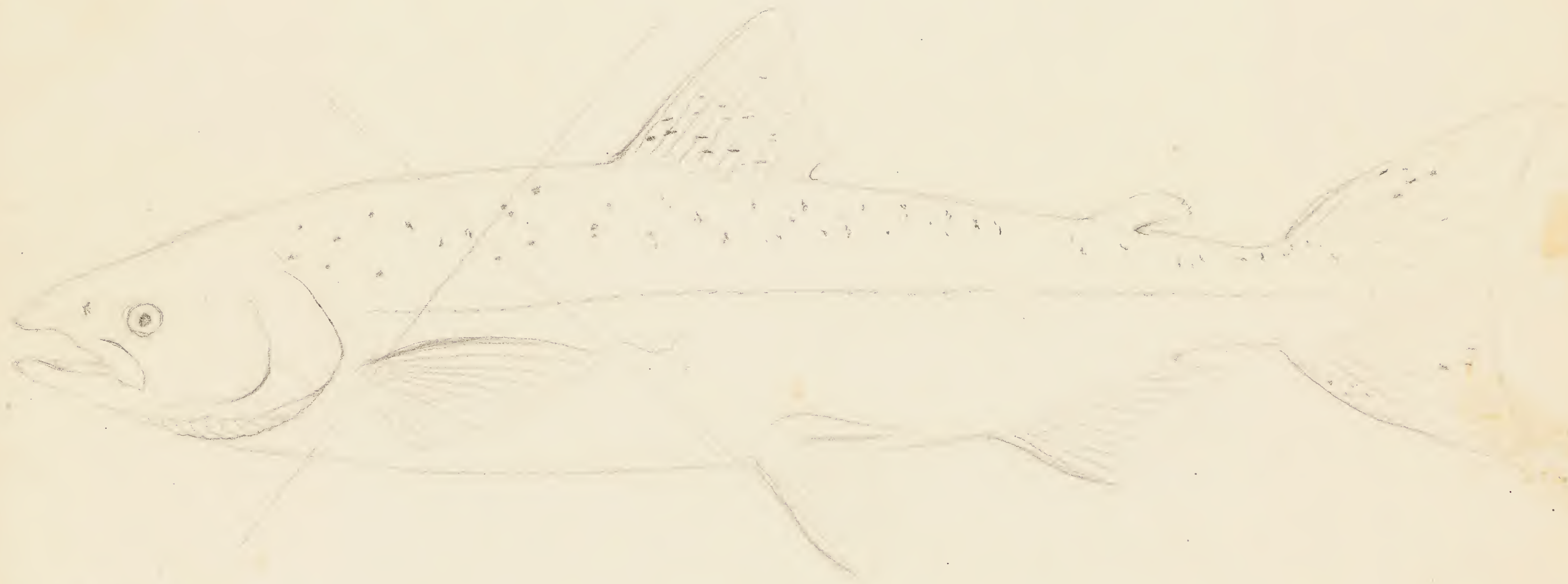

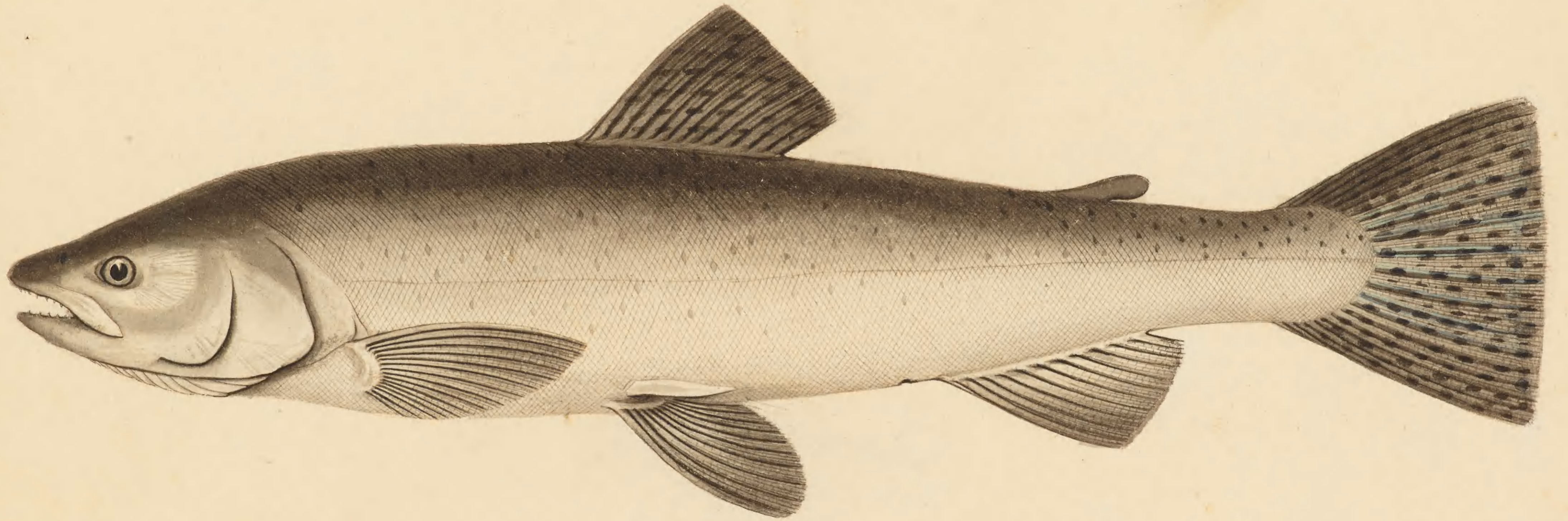

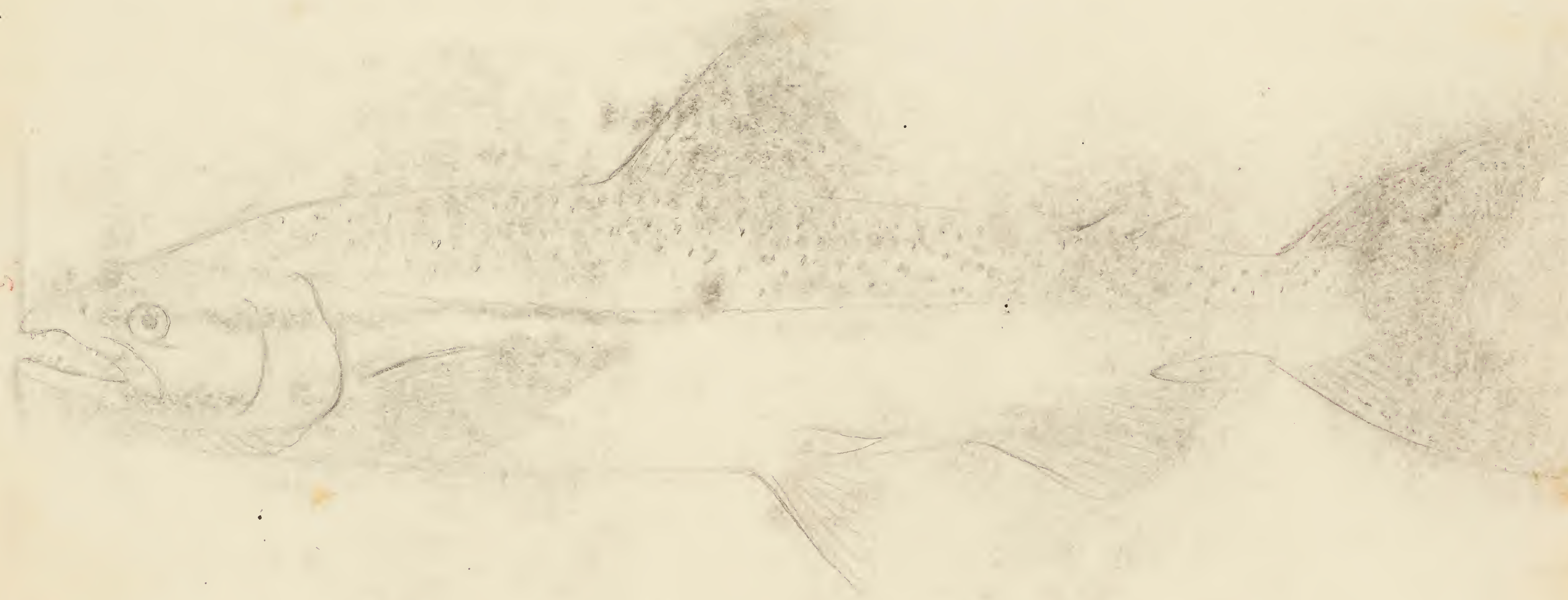
Shape & position of Scales.
