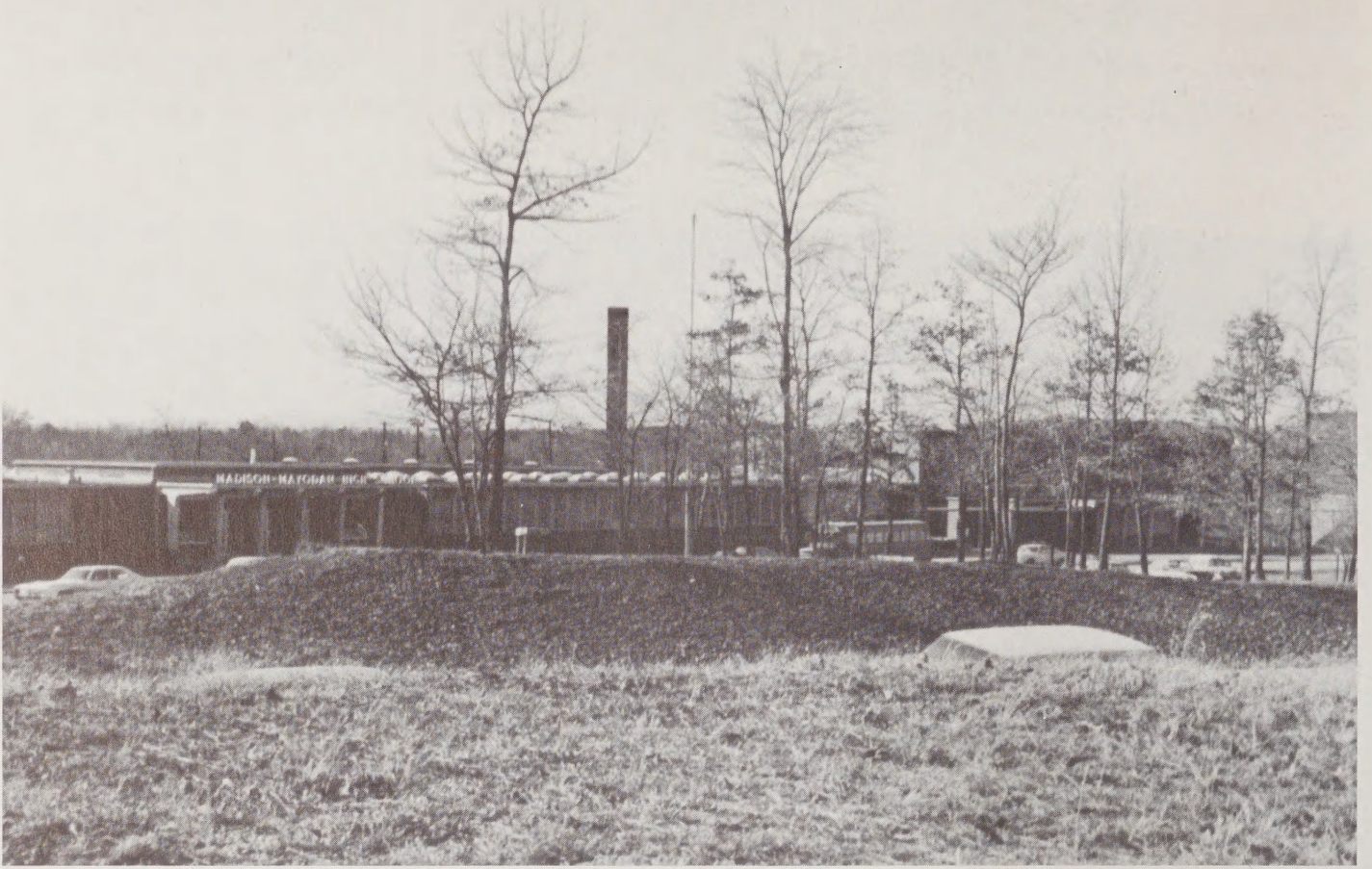
# STUDENT LIFE

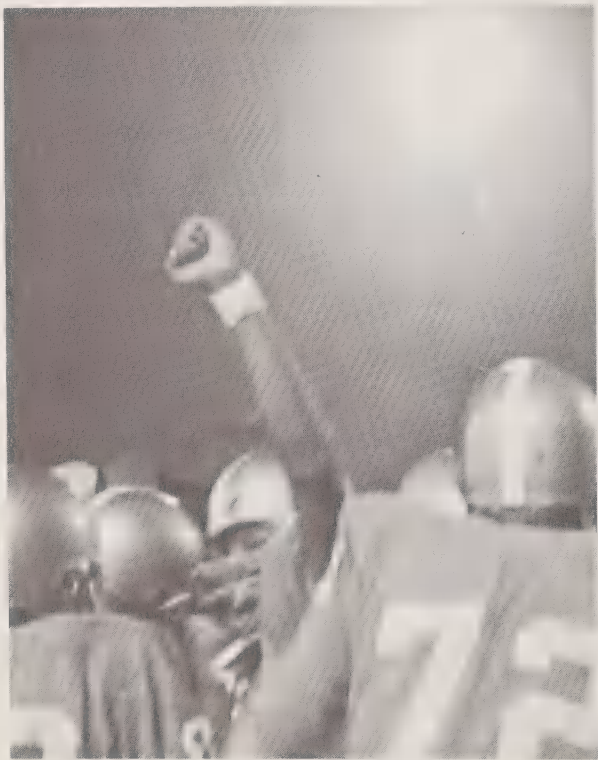

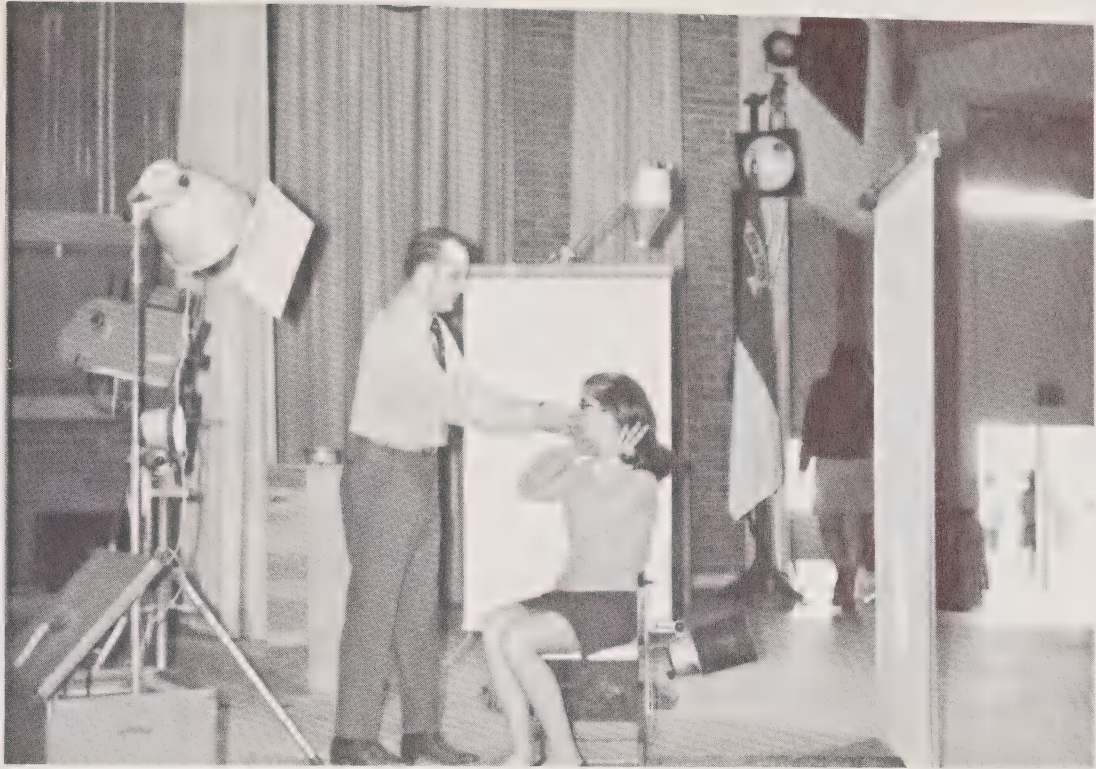

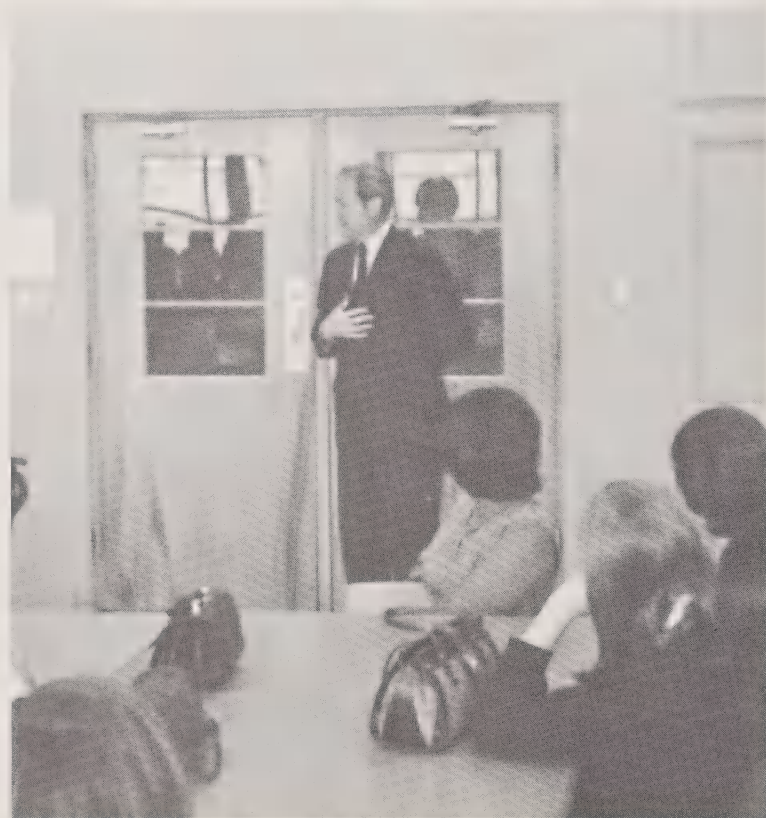

The National Honor Society inducted twelve Junior members, one of the highest numbers ever.

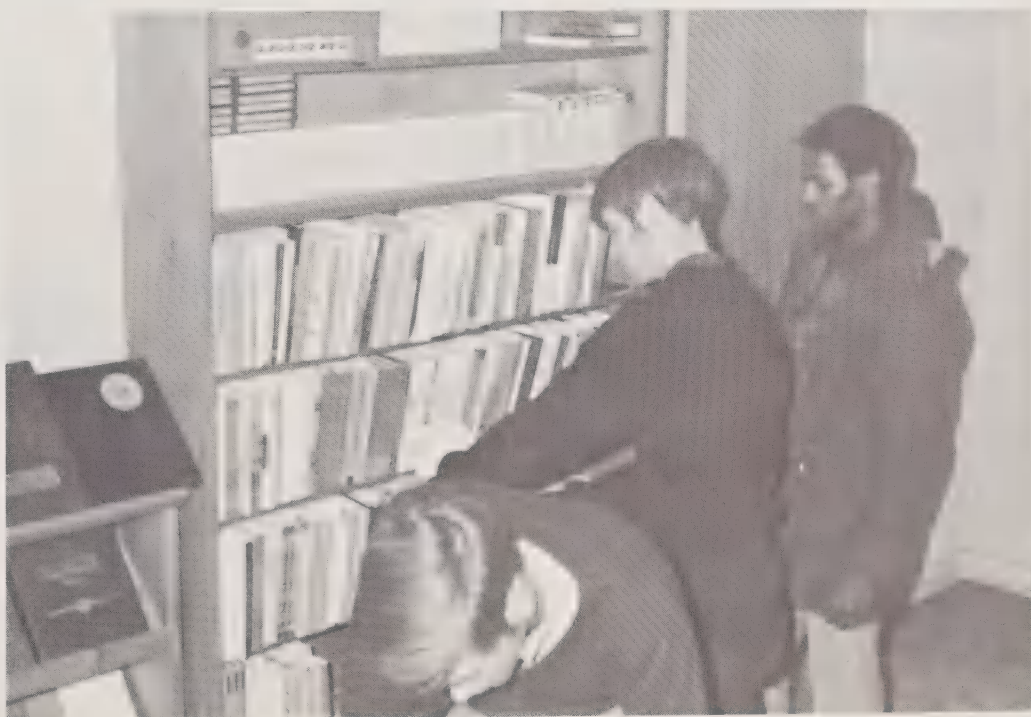




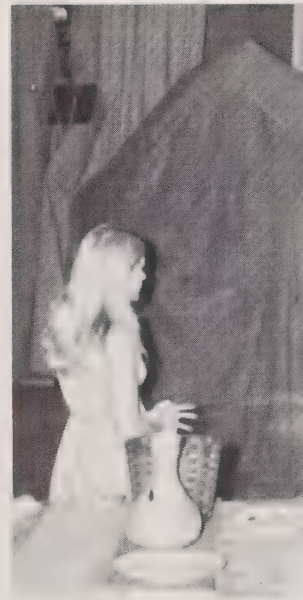


Congressman L. Richardson Preyer talked to our Social Studies classes.

The Drama Club produced "Exit, The Body". It was hilarious.





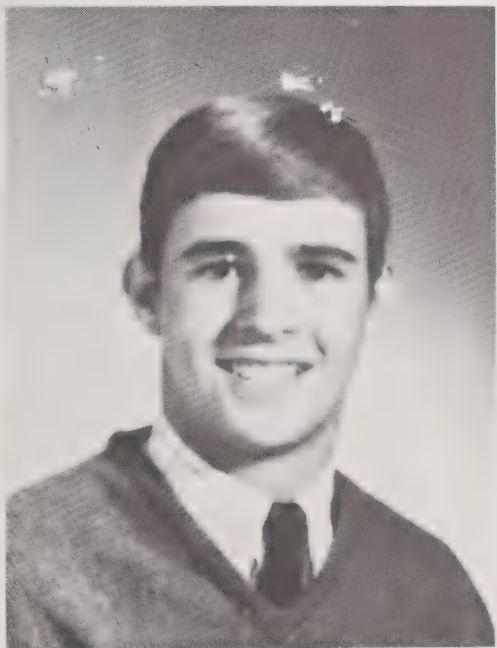

And what will come of those who graduate? What will they do? Where will they go? In America, where there is democracy, let them think freely and let them express their opinions. Let



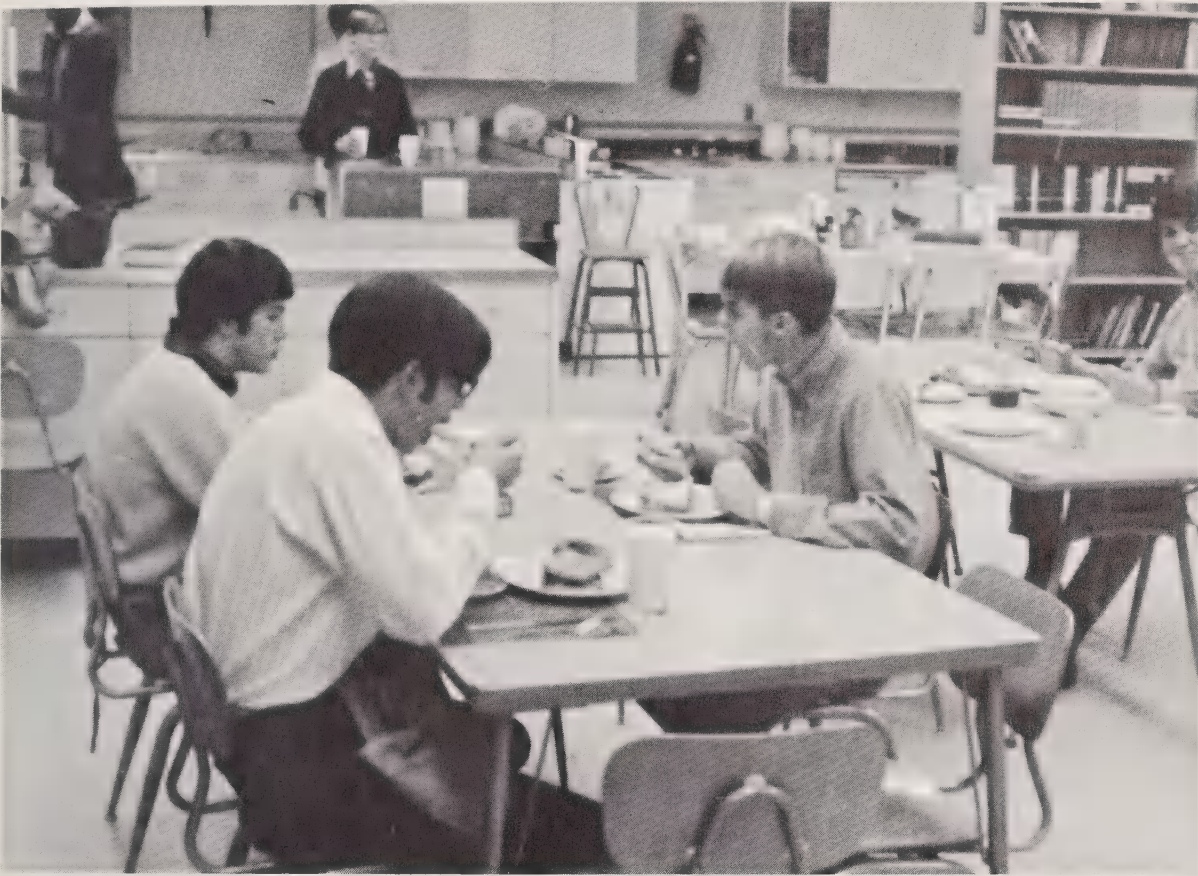


them instigate change, for without it, we live not our own lives, but those of generations before us. Most of all, let them get from life that which life was created for.










And, if when historians write about the graduates and this generation, they say that we tried to improve this life and this environment just a little bit, then none of this will have been in vain.
