## VOICE OF DEMOCRACY

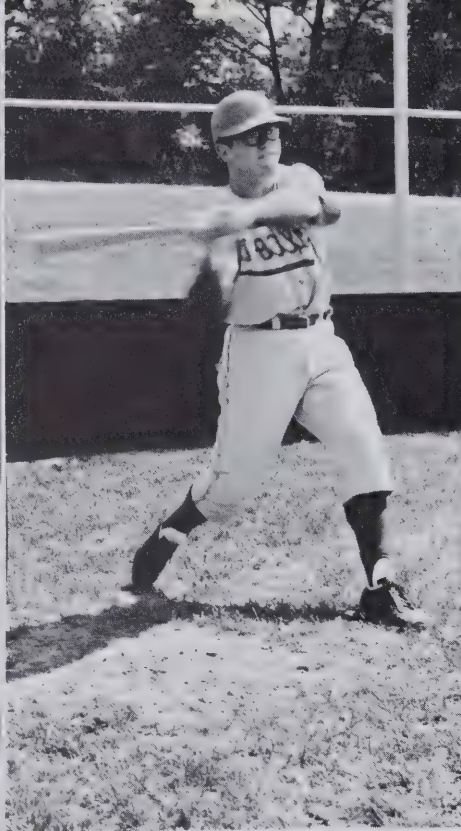

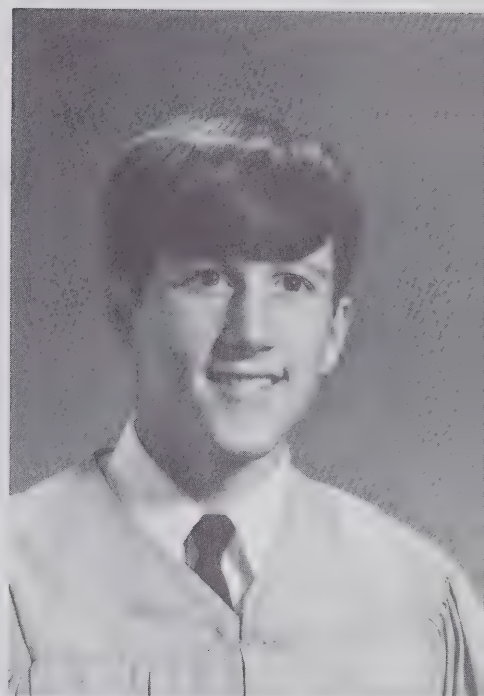

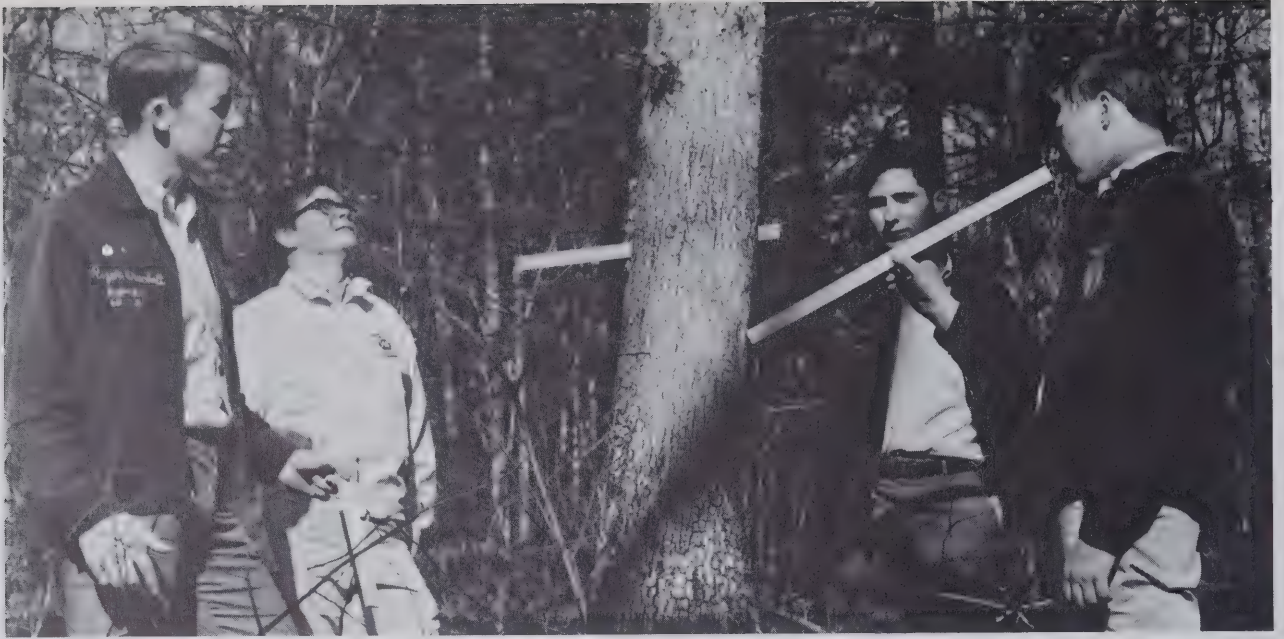




## DECA DISTRICT OFFICERS
