


















DEDICATION

"Spirit of the Falcon 76"

Saint Aucustine's College has encountered all types of spirit since its existence in 1867. Spirits which depicts the nature and love of the 'Aug' family. Thus doing, this Bicentennial Era of America, Saint Augustine's role mean a great deal to the Administration, Students, Alumni and Friends. Yes, we too have a vital part in the history of America.

During the past one hundred and nine years, Saint Augustine's College bas made it possible for Black students to be educated in order to contribute to the growth of America. Amongst these walls has past creat leaders of yesterday and even more for tomorrow. So as you view the 76 Annual of Saint Augustine's College, remember that we too have that Spirit of Love that encounters for a new tomorrow.

History of Saint Augustine's College

Saint Augustine's College was founded in 1867 through the combined efforts of the Freemen's Commission of the Protestant Episcopal Church and a group of clergy and laymen of the Espiscopal Diocese of North Carolina under the leadership of Bishop Thomas Atkinson. During its history, St. Augustine's College has had eight principals or presidents.

The first principal, the Rev. J. Brinton Smith who was serving as secretary of the Freemen's Commission when the institution was being founded, stated that only four pupils were enrolled, on the first day of operation. By the end of the session of 1871–72, the enrollment had increased to 110, including boarding students.

Upon the death of Dr. Smith in 1872, the Rev. J. E. C. Smedes took over the office of principal and maintained this position until 1884 when he was succeeded by the Rev. Robert B. Sutton.

Dr. Hunter became the principal in 1891 and remained in that position until 1916. During the Hunter administration, the curriculum was expanded, St. Agnes Hospital was founded, and the Chapel and Benson Library were constructed.

The Bishop Tuttle School was established by the Women's Auxiliary at Saint Augustine's College and began its first session in the fall of 1925 with Miss Bertha Richards as Dean. After the retirement of the Rev. Edgar H. Goold in 1947, Dr. Harold L. Trigg was elected president, becoming the first Negro president. During his administration the Penick Hall of Science was constructed.

Dr. James A. Boyer, son of the first dean and himself a former dean of the College, became president in 1955. During his administration the enrollment of St. Augustine's doubled, faculty salaries were substantially increased and the physical plant greatly expanded. Dr. Boyer's resignation and plans to return to the classroom were announced on May 24, 1966 by the Right Rev. Thomas A. Fraser, Bishop of the Diocese of North Carolina and Chairman of the Board of Trustees. Concomitantly, Dr. Prezell R. Robinson, Executive Dean and Professor of Sociology was appointed Acting President. On February 27, 1967, Dr. Robinson was elected President of the College.

Today Saint Augustine's College has broaden its cirriculum base to center around teaching students to think critically and creatively. Under Dr. Robinson's administration St. Aug. has grown through enrollment and various buildings have been constructed which would include: New Library, Boyer Classroom, Martin Luther King Student Union with Mall and reflecting lights, Latham Hall and construction is underway for the new fine arts building for the department of art and music. Each president has added to the "Aug" something through his innovative ideas and imput, but no one has built this institution on his own.

Yes, Saint Augustine's College has come along way and we the "Aug" family, would like to see it progress even more. Saint Augustine's College has progressed in the past and will continue to progress in the future.

A BRIEF HISTORY

Honor Societies

Beta Kappa Chi Society for Natural Science majors was established at St. Augustine College in 1957. Membership is based upon character, leadership and a 3.00 point average in the Natural Sciences.

Alpha Kappa Mu was established at St. Augustine's in May, 1950. Membership is open to all majors based upon character, leadership, and a cummulative scholastic average of 3.30.

Beta Kappa Chi, Science honor society, was established at St. Augustine's in 1951. Membership is based upon character, leadership and a 3.00 average in science.

Sigma Tau Delta was established at St. Augustine's in 1972. Membership is based upon character, leadership and a cummulative scholastic average of at least 3.00 in English. The student must be a major in English.

Delta Mu Delta was established at St. Augustine's in 1972. Membership is based upon character, leadership and a cummulative scholastic average of 3.20 in Business Administration. The student must be a Business major. Its motto is "Excellence Through Knowledge".

Sigma Rho Sigma, honor society for social science majors, was established at St. Augustine's in 1954. Membership is based on character, leadership, a 3.00 average in social science.

Alpha Kappa Delta Honor Society is open to majors in Sociology who are outstanding in the field, manifest potential leadership and have a cummulative average 3.1. The College has not established its own chapter, but is affiliated with North Carolina State University in Raleigh.

Who's Who in American Universities and Colleges was established in the fall of 1960. Membership is based upon outstanding character, leadership, and scholarship.

Greeks and Social Fellowships

Alpha Phi Alpha, the first black Fraternity was founded on the campus of Cornell University. Ithica, New York, on December 4, 1906. The racial cleavage, characteristic of this period, had stimulated seven bold black students to form a group of minority people to insure mutual helpfulness.

These seven students are known to members of the fraternity as Jewels. Their courageous act was the initial step toward forming other fraternities. The ideas and principles upon which this fraternity was founded influenced many great men to join. Besides brotherhood, APA is based on knowledge and achievement.

Gamma Xi Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. was founded on March 26. 1949 here at St. Augustine's College. As in previous years, the members have carried on traditional projects. Alpha Kappa Alpha women hold as their guiding light the motto: "Advancement through knowledge and Achievement."

Delta Sigma Theta is a National Greek-letter Sorority Founded at Howard University in Washington, D.C. on January 13, 1913. The founders envisioned an organization of College women pledged to serious endeavors, community services and to promote high cultural standards among its members of the larger society in which it existed. Today there are over seventy-five thousand members and more than four hundred chapters in forty states and the Republic of Haiti and Liberia. On January 12, 1963, at its fiftieth anniversary celebrated in Washington, D.C., President John F. Kennedy, the guest of honor, congratulated the organization on its service to the country.

Omega Psi Phi Fraternity was founded on the campus of Howard University on November 17, 1911. The purpose of our fraternity is to mold and shape young college men, who meet the general and specific standards of Fraternity-ship, into a finer product — a whole man.

Zeta Phi Beta was founded on the campus of Howard University in 1920. As a link in the great international chain, that is striving to make meaningful its ideals of Service, Scholarship and sisterhood. Through all its endeavors, the chapter has been guided by its motto, "Finer Womanhood".

Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity Inc., was founded on the campus of Howard University on January 9, 1914. Beta XI chapter was organized here at Saint Augustine's in 1944. The motto of the Fraternity is "Culture for Service and Service to Humanity."

Sigma Gamma Rho, the youngest of the Greek letter collegiate sororities and now an interracial organization, was organized November 12, 1922, by seven young teachers in Indianapolis, Indiana. On December 30, 1929, the sorority was incorporated as a National Collegiate sorority and a charter was granted to Alpha Chapter at Butler University. The sorority strives to foster ideals and encourage and up-right living among women.

Kappa Alpha Psi was founded on the campus of Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana. January 5. 1911. The chief aim of Kappa Alpha Psi is to provide the climate within which students may acquire a sound moral, intellectual and social basis for effective living.


Nu Gamma Alpha Inc., was organized at Howard University in 1962, since then Nu Gamma Alpha has been spreading rapidly in the CIAA. Nu Gamma Alpha was organized on St. Augustine's campus on October 17, 1970.

Swing Phi Swing Inc., was organized at WSSU on April 4, 1969. On December 3, 1971 43 young women who had similar aims and objectives organized the NKIJHA Chapter on the Campus of St. Augustine's College. SOS is a Social Fellowship dedicated to uniting black womanhood and encouraging scholastic abilities. SOS was the dawning of beautiful age of Black womanhood.


Grove Phi Grove Social Fellowship, Inc. was organized at Morgan State College in October 12, 1962. On December 8, 1968 ten young men who had similar aims and objectives organized the chapter here at St. Augustine's College. Groove Phi Groove is a social organization in which men of like attainment and same standards, ideals and ideals work together through self-expression, to achieve and maintain stated cardinal principles. These principles are scholarship unity, leadership and good character.
