5869 Hevea relative. Very tall, 90-100 ft. basal diam. up to 30 ft. Buttress + stilt roots. Latex very sparse, buff. Bark smooth hard, ^{not det. by} red brown. Leaves lebrona^{thick}. Fruit large, eggshaped, not baccate. Valves splitting just as in Hevea, woody. Seeds ^{Parigakp anterosus} large, ellipsoid, testa glossy red brown or ^{light} sepia with no spots. In terra firme. Fruit eaten after boiling 30 x in water. Poison.

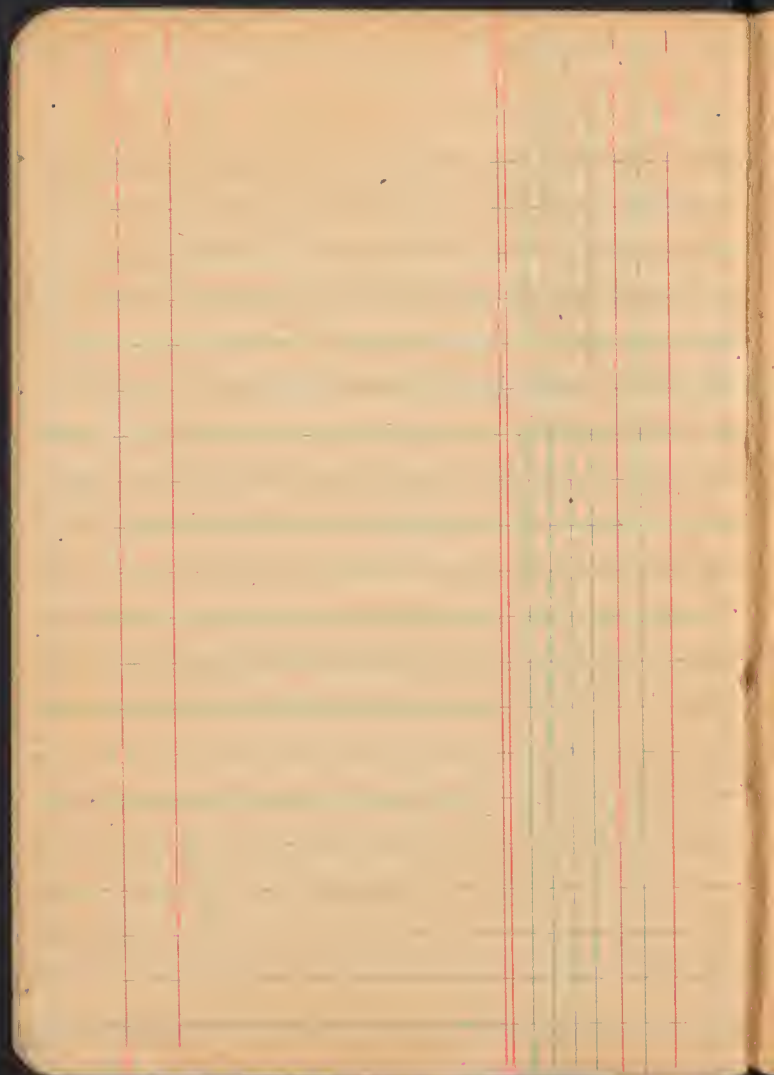
