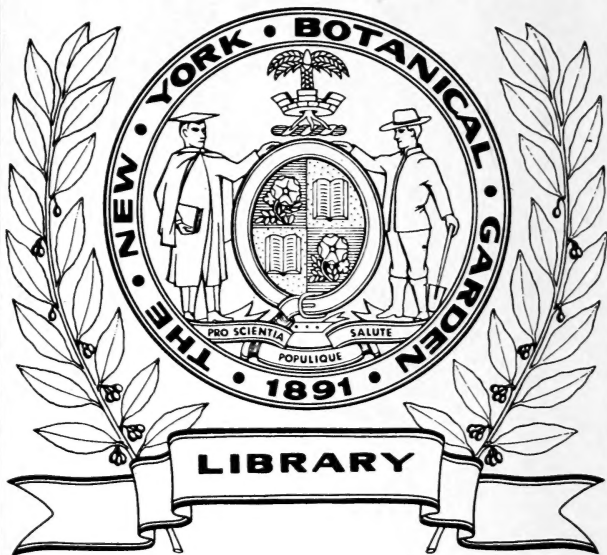

TO THE PURCHASERS OR HOLDERS OF THE PRO- DROMUS FLORÆ COLUMBIANÆ.

The compiler (Dr. Brereton, U. S. A.) presents his due acknowledgements to the above patrons of science, and informs them, that, after *three* botanical seasons "*The Club*" have been unable to add a *single* plant to the catalogue; though they have not been remiss in seizing with avidity every occasion afforded during that time for botanical analysis.

He, however, excepts, with great pleasure, the acute scrutiny of his friend, Wm. Mechlin, Esq. a gentleman of very superior attainments, who has found *three* plants, not contained in the catalogue; two of which are recognized by the compiler, as old acquaintances; but the *third* is duly acknowledged a stranger. Below are Mr. Mechlin's observations, copied from his note to the compiler; and they can be easily added to the Pro-dromus, which will *then* be *complete*.

The compiler takes this occasion to inform them, that, in the fulfilment of his duties, he will be unable to complete the *Flora*, as therein announced; but he sincerely hopes, that a more competent hand will undertake it, who has freely his permission to use the foundation thus afforded.

[Found in the low grounds immediately north of the Capitol, in company with *Habenaria ciliaris*, *psycodes*, &c. 2d August 1833.]

1st. DIDYNAMIA ANGIOSPERMIA.

Scutellaria ambigua. Nuttall. ♀. (1831.)

[On rocks below the Paper Mill, and near the Episcopal Burial Ground; transplanted and flowered several times in my garden.]

2d. DIADELPHIA OCTANDRIA.

Folygala incarnata.

[I have seen it in several places, in Com. Porter's woods, 1831; but in most abundance in the locality indicated above.]

PREFACE.

During the spring of the year 1825, after the dissolution of the late Washington Botanical Society, a few gentlemen of this city, devoted to the science of Botany, formed an association, with an earnest determination to explore and to investigate, *de novo*, the indigenous plants growing in the District of Columbia. The association, under the name of "The Botanic club," consisted of Wm. Mechlin, Wm. Rich, Alex'r McWilliams, M. D., the compiler, and during the following year, of James W. Robbins, M. D., but who, afterwards, in the succeeding one, removed from the District. The Prodrum, herewith submitted to the public, is, so far, the result of their investigations to the present time; and, there is no doubt, that, their contemplated Flora, will contain a much more augmented catalogue, more particularly, among the *species*, than is now presented.

The erudite Botanist will be astonished to perceive the names of several plants, in this Prodrum, which, he is well aware belong to other localities; but when he considers the various and alpine sources

of our majestic Potomac, on whose stream their rudiments are borne, and deposited along its bank, his astonishment will cease; at the *Falls*, too, on both sides of the river, we have never failed, at each successive excursion, to procure plants that were before unknown to us, and add the strangers to our catalogue. Among them, for the present, may be mentioned, the *Dracocephalum denticulatum*, *Silene regia*, *Tillæa cymosa*, *Gerardia auriculata*, and others. The latter is now found abundantly on the low banks of the Eastern-branch, (the Anacostia, within our limits,) and a specimen of the first was sent to Z. Collins, Esq., whose tact and acumen in Botanical knowledge is unrivalled, who compared it with those of his own Herbarium, and with that of the late Rev. Dr. Muhlenberg's which now belongs to him: he fortified our decision.* This plant, as well as the *Tillæa cymosa*, was strictly *scrutinized* by Dr. Darlington, during his last attendance in the House of Representatives, whose opinion coincided with that of the club.

Perhaps, also, from the abovementioned cause, may be traced in some degree, but,

more particularly, from the enthusiasm and zealous energy of the members in this delightful science, the large preponderance in the number of the *Genera* of the *phænogamous* plants, that are intended to be described in the *Flora*, in comparison with those of other authors on American Botany. At the end of this article a table is exhibited of the number described by each, as well as the time of their respective publications. On a reference to the table, it will not escape observation, the great disparity existing between the result of the labours of Michaux and son, with those of the late Mr. Elliott, of Charleston, S. C.: the former after exploring, during six years, the whole northern continent of America, published in Paris, their *Flora Boreali-Americana*; while, the states of South Carolina and Georgia, only, are the limit to the indefatigable research, and unwearied zeal of the latter, who modestly styles it a *Sketch* of the botany of those two states.

It may not be amiss, here, to state the following singular occurrences respecting the growth of some plants noticed by one of the members, in which the rest fully concur, as appears from an extract of the

succeeding communication:—"It would appear from recent observations, that some plants are *periodical* in their ~~in-ef-~~ florescence; or, from some unknown cause disappear for several years at a time; for instance, the *Orchis spectabilis* was found by members of the late Botanical Society, 8 or 10 years ago; and, altho' the most diligent search has been made for it, for at least *five* years past, it has not been discovered until this season, when it is very abundant, and has been found in various parts of the District, by different individuals. I have also observed, that the *Arethusa bulbosa*, is very abundant some years, and, during others, *extremely* rare. About five years since, *Batschia canescens*, was found in great abundance, near the Race-course, but has never been seen since.

NOTE.

* The following is an extract from Mr. Collins' letter on this subject—

PHILADELPHIA, March 7th, 1822.

"Your plant I take to be *Dracocephalum denticulatum*,
 " Ait. It agrees well with a specimen in my collection, so
 " marked, which many years since I brought from the farm of
 " Col. Graham, near where the Potomac marble is quarried:
 " but they might, perhaps, be considered as holding an inter-
 " mediate station between that species and *D. Virginicum*, if

“ they be really distinct. Aiton’s description of the former
 “ has *foliis obovati-lanceolatis*; but the figure in Curtis’s mag-
 “ azine does not give the leaves, so formed. Michaux, who,
 “ must have seen our plant, gives but one species, *Virginicum*,
 “ to which he has referred (erroneously as to one) all of Wal-
 “ ter (*Prasium*.) In our, immediate, vicinity I have not met
 “ with any *Dracocephalum*, save in the Botanic gardens. The
 “ two just mentioned, in all the *play* between both, abound in
 “ the south-west part of Pennsylvania. Muhlenberg, I know,
 “ referred our plant to Curtis’s figure of *denticulatum*. The
 “ leaves, of several species, are destitute of serratures towards
 “ their base. Vide, Pursh, Walter, and Michaux.

“ The islands and margins of the Potomac, afford the Bo-
 “ tanist fine scope, borne as the seeds are, by its waters from
 “ beyond the mountains, and from the southern region of its
 “ Shenandoah’s head.”

The CLASSES are *fifteen*, not distinguished by any particular appellations. One of them is *Acotyledonous* (plants destitute of a *Cotyledon*;) three are *Monocotyledonous* (plants with a simple undivided *Embryo*;) * the remaining eleven *Dicotyledonous* (plants whose *Embryo* divides at the top into two parts or lobes, which are the *Cotyledons*.) †

The ORDERS are *one hundred*, distributed in natural series under every class, and each defined by rather full definitions, taken, in the first place, from the parts of Fructification, and illustrated by secondary characters, founded on any other circumstance.

The GENERA stand, in one or more sections, according to their respective affinities, and with their essential characters under each order, at the end of which are usually many valuable critical remarks.

* The embryo or germ of the *Seed*, called *corculum* by Linnaeus. This part sends out the *Root* downwards, and the *Plumula*, or bud of the *Stem* or *Herbage*, upwards.

† The *Cotyledons* or *Seed lobes* are closely attached to the *Embryo*, commonly two, rarely more, in some tribes altogether wanting. They either ascend out of the ground, and perform for a while the office of *Leaves*, or remain buried, till they gradually decay.
