## PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Do not change collections or special sets. The collections are made up as they are for definite reasons and we cannot change them. Any of these collections or specials are very good value.

Do not split quantities as listed. Where a variety is listed at 2 for ${ }^{\prime} 15$ cents or 4 for 15 cents do not order 1 or 2 at a lower price. There is no profit in any items of less than ten cents and very little at that price. No single item accepted for less than ten cents.

EXTRAS ON CASH ORDERS. On cash orders of $\$ 2.00$ to $\$ 5.00$ you can select $10 \%$ extra in bulbs of your own choosing. From $\$ 5.00$ to $\$ 25.00$ select $15 \% ; \$ 25.00$ to $\$ 50.00$ select $20 \%$ and above $\$ 50.00$ select $25 \%$. These Discounts do not Apply to Collections, Special Offers or Wholesale prices or New Introductions. See next page.

TO MAKE OUT YOUR ORDER put everything down on the order blank, just as listed in the price list. Add it up, then figure out any special discounts or add on the extra bulbs of your choosing. It is all very simple but some people seem to have a lot of trouble in making out an order.

On orders of $\$ 30.00$ or more I will put in a free bulb of ........ listed below.
The above discounts and extras are all for cash orders. The earlier the orders are received and the larger they are the more generous we will be with our extras. If you cannot spare all the cash now send $25 \%$ and the balance later and we will see that you are satisfied. But the above extras are only for cash before shipment.

On cash orders of $\$ 12.00$ or more, except collections, I will give a copy of the "Gladiolus Book" by Rockwell if you ask for it and if you have not already had one.

Packages of bulblets run from twenty-five to fifty or more. We give very good value.
You can have 3 bulbs at the 10 rate; 25 at the 100 rate. But no single items for less than 10 cents.

Please do not send us orders of under $\$ 1.00$ as we lose money on them. I do usually fill such orders from regular customers as an accommodation but they cost us more than we get for them.

I GUARANTEE SATISFACTION, and I mean just that. If at any time, either after receiving the bulbs or after blooming, you have cause for complaint just write me about it and I will do my utmost to make things right. This is the only basis on which anyone can hope to conduct a business that will be permanently successful.

At these prices all bulbs, except the wholesale offers, are prepaid anywhere in the United States and Canada and all countries in the Postal Union.

SPECIAL QUOTATIONS. Do not ask for special quotations unless you have a large order. We will not consider quoting any special prices on small orders. I publish this price list to give people the prices and do not consider it honest to give one person a lower price than another.

REMEMBER in buying bulbs price is not everything. In fact sometimes the price is a minor item. Consider the quality, count, the reliability of the grower, etc. I always mean to put in enough extra count or over size to make up for any lower price that other good reliable growers might make. Just leave it to me.

IF YOU WANT TO PAY TRANSPORTATION and get extra count on your order just mention it and I will send your order collect for postage or express and will see that you are more than satisfied. Just mention whether you want extra count on your order or extras in other kinds and what kinds. If you want bulbs sent by mail it is better to let us send them C.O.D. for the postage, then we know the postage is correct and I will give you more than enough bulbs to make it up. People who send stamps or cash for the postage seldom send enough.

ON FAIR SIZED ORDERS, EXPRESS is safest and best especially in the winter time; I advise express if you are situated so as to get free delivery by the express company.

EXTRAS. It is the practice of most growers to give extras on orders. I always put in some myself. So it would help me if you will mention whether you want extras of the same varieties that you order or in other kinds. And if you have a preference it will help me still more if you can name the varieties in which you want your extras and if you want large, medium or small bulbs or bulblets. Just give us a list of varieties from which to select your extras. We will put in what we think the order rates.

Please give me a list from which to select your extras. Extras are given for orders from the retail list-not from the wholesale tho I usually put in something new to try anyway.

TITAN. PALMER SEEDLING No. 32194. A huge bright rose salmon with $6-9$ blooms open at a time. Grows six feet tall with enormously large, strong foliage. Sometimes the heads crook a little but not bad. This past season had some wonderfully fine spikes of this variety. I am sure you will like it. A bulb of Titan given free with $\$ 30.00$ worth of bulbs from this price list.

ORDER EARLY. By ordering early and paying cash you can make use of the coupons on the back page and save a good bit of money in that way. Also you will be sure to get what you want. Always there are some items in this fall list that are sold out before my catalog comes out in January. So to make sure that you get just the kinds that you want to grow next year order as early as possible. Have had many fine reports on bulbs that we sent out last year and from the inquiries coming in it looks as if there would be a big demand this year.


## New Varieties for 1939

This year I am offering several new very fine varieties that are going places. Every one of them is outstanding. They are as fine a lot of seedlings as were ever put out by any introducer in any one year.

One innovation we are making this year is dropping the price of the bulbs of the main introductions to $\$ 6.00$ each and selling bulblets also. I find that not many people are paying $\$ 10.00$ for bulbs no matter how good a variety may be. But with a lower price and the opportunity to get bulblets the first year we are hoping that more people will take advantage of this innovation and will get in on the new varieties at the start.

## The Palmer Introductions

ALGONQUIN. The finest red I have seen. A decided improvement on Regent, as good as that variety is. A bright red with 7-9 large blooms open at a time on a tall straight stem.

BUCCANEER. This is a color sport of Pirate. Nice clear rose color with a darker blotch. Has all the beauty of form of Pirate and is identical with that variety except it has this fine rose pink color.

JASMINE. The most beautiful variety I have seen in yellow. The color is something like the inside of a lemon. To me it does not seem like a yellow but I suppose would be put in that class. Beautifully ruffled and a solid clear shade. One of the most beautiful varieties I have ever seen. This is the only variety ever given a first class certificate by the Canadian Gladiolus Society.

SNOW WHITE. An immense pure snow white beautifully ruffled. By far the most beautiful white I have ever known. Not a commercial but for the home garden a "must have."

For premium bulbs we have a soft rose pink opening eight or nine at a time and a huge very strong growing dark salmon with enormous flowers.

The premium bulb, seedling 30114, that was used last year has been named FIREFLY.
We have had so many good reports on red seedling 27271 and also on the orange seedling BC25084 and requests to have these named that we have decided to name the red one BOLIVAR and the orange one SOLITA.

Of varieties from other hybridizers we have an extremely early rose pink from Miss Beatrice L. Palmer. I think this is the earliest variety I have. It certainly bloomed ahead of anything else this past year and is a very nice color. It is not named yet.

DIANE from Walter L. Krueger of Wisconsin. This is a very beautiful salmon orange with clear cream throat. Looks very much like one of Palmer's varieties. It was fine in my own garden this past season and I understand from others who have seen it growing at home that it is one of the very best.

One of the most sensational varieties since Picardy was introduced is one that I am putting out for Mr. C. C. Marshall of Canada. This is also not named yet but it sure is going to make a reputation for Mr. Marshall. It is a rose color shading lighter toward the throat especially in the upper throat. Very heavily ruffled and huge in size. It makes Picardy, grown under the same conditions, look rather ordinary.

Amrita, Amulet, Barcarole and Jasmine, which I am introducing this year. four sister seedlings. are the very ultimate of beauty: Can't imagine anything finer. Amberglow, Sahara, Vagabond Prince, Beacon are wonderfully fine varieties that are getting down in price now to where the average amateur can buy them. These are all crackerjacks. Jalna is another one that is down in price and is becoming one of the most popular smokics on the market. For early commercials Maytime and Token are going over big. Premier Henry though not so tall as we would like is one of the very finest and is being used very successfully by . \ir. Palmer in his hybridizing. It is the parent of some of his best seecllings. Have had fine reports on Carillon. It is one of the best pinks. In purple, King Lear is by far the largest and most beautiful I have ever seen. Damaris, a clear burgundy red or purple and Simcoe, a light purple are also vers fine. These will make better commercials than King Lear though they are not so large and of an entirely different type. Margaret Beaton is proving one of the most beautiful and finest whites with blotch. Though Rewi Fallu has not received good reports from evervwhere possibly because the people were expecting too much from it, it is still a magnificent variety for the home garden. It is not a commercial but one that everyone who likes dark reds should grow: Another one that has been magnificent in our garden this year is Timbuctoo. I rate this a four star variety. It is a magnificent thing for the home garden and though it is not a commercial shade of red the florists should use it when it gets cheaper. We made some very beautiful funeral spravs of it this year and people called for it by name. I am sorry but Lutex is not quite so good as it was the ycar previous. It seems to have too strong a tendency to crook. Shirley Temple is another that crooks under some conditions but when bloomed late in the season or in cool weather is very fine and is one of my farorites at any time even with its tendency to crook. Alayne though not large is a very beautiful color and fine for floral work. The premium bulb. 30114, that I gave out last vear has been named Firefly. Have had some wonderfully fine reports on this. For an early red of the brightest shade it has everything else beaten. In white Maid of Orleans is the best all purpose white though Star of Bethlehem is larger and will make a larger spike. Mary Elizabeth is beautifully ruffled and is the best late white. Regent is the best bright red I have seen for an all-purpose scarlet but unfortunately my stock got mixed this past year so am not listing it at wholesale.

## Napthalene Flakes

If you have been troubled with thrip on your glads this past season or even if you haven't it is well to treat the bulbs this winter with napthalene flakes. The bulbs should be thoroughly cured and dried out, cleaned up and then kept in a fairly warm place, that is sixty degrees or above for about a month. Scatter on napthalene flakes at the rate of about one ounce to 100 bulbs. Cover the boxes with paper or something else to confine the fumes, then after about a month shake the napthalene off thoroughly and store the bulbs in a cool place. This will insure your bulbs being clean of thrip or eggs.

I can furnish the napthalene flakes for 50 cents for a package of nearly two pounds. I do not sell less than a full package but whatever you do not use this year can be saved over for next season. Keep in a closed container.

## Euphorbia Corolata <br> (FLOWERING SPURGE)

This is a hardy perennial somewhat similar to double Baby's Breath but blossoms later. Blooms through August and September. Just the thing to go with glads or any other kind of flower. Will grow on most any kind of soil, even on dry sand, but good garden soil will make it very much better.

This is a plant that should be grown in every garden and commercial growers should plant it by the hundred. Absolutely hardy and I am sure you will like it.

In the northern states I would suggest Euphorbia be planted early in the spring. In the south or where it does not freeze hard, fall planting would be perfectly all right.

Though Euphorbia is easy to handle, and there should be no reason for it not doing well, I have had some complaints about the roots not growing. I don't know why this is because if they are planted at once and given a good watering they should all grow. I have had no trouble with them myself. But in as much as I have had some complaints I no longer guarantee the roots. I do give good strong healthy roots and if given half a chance they should grow but if they do not grow I shall not be responsible

## HOW TO CARE FOR BULBS IN THE FALL

Dig them a month or more after they are through blooming. If the foliage stays green and healthy it will do no harm to leave them till hard freezing weather. When you dig them cut the tops off immediately and place the bulbs in shallow trays in a cool airy place. 2-5 weeks after digging they should be dried and cured enough to take off the old bulbs and bulblets.

After thoroughly drying them it is well to do something to kill any possible thrip that might be on the bulbs. Many people scatter napthalene flakes over them. If you have only a few hundred bulbs I can send you a package of nearly two pounds for 50 cents prepaid. This will take care of up to two or three thousand bulbs. When you use this keep them in a fairly warm place, scatter on the napthalene, about 1 oz . to 100 bulbs, and cover them with a paper or cloth to confine the fumes. After about a month shake off the napthalene, which can be saved for another year, and then store the bulbs away in a cool place for the winter.

Many people now are using Rototox in which they soak the bulbs for a day or two. This will kill all thrip and eggs. This is also said to check disease. It is not poisonous to people and so is safer to use than bichloride, and it does not require a glass, earthen or wooden container to dip them in. For further information about this write Rototox, 813 Yale St., East Williston, N. Y.

Some people where they haven't too many bulbs soak them in Bichloride of Mercury in the fall after the bulbs are thoroughly cured. I think this will help to control any disease germs that may be on the bulbs and would kill any thrip besides.

We do not hear near so much about thrip now as we did a few years ago. Most people are either using napthalene or soaking their bulbs and spraying them and are having fine results.

THRIP. If you are a beginner and don't know what thrip is I will say that it is a very small black insect that sucks the juices from the buds so that they don't open properly. This has caused a lot of trouble around the country but by using well known precautionary measures as above, it can be easily avoided and goood glads can be grown.
