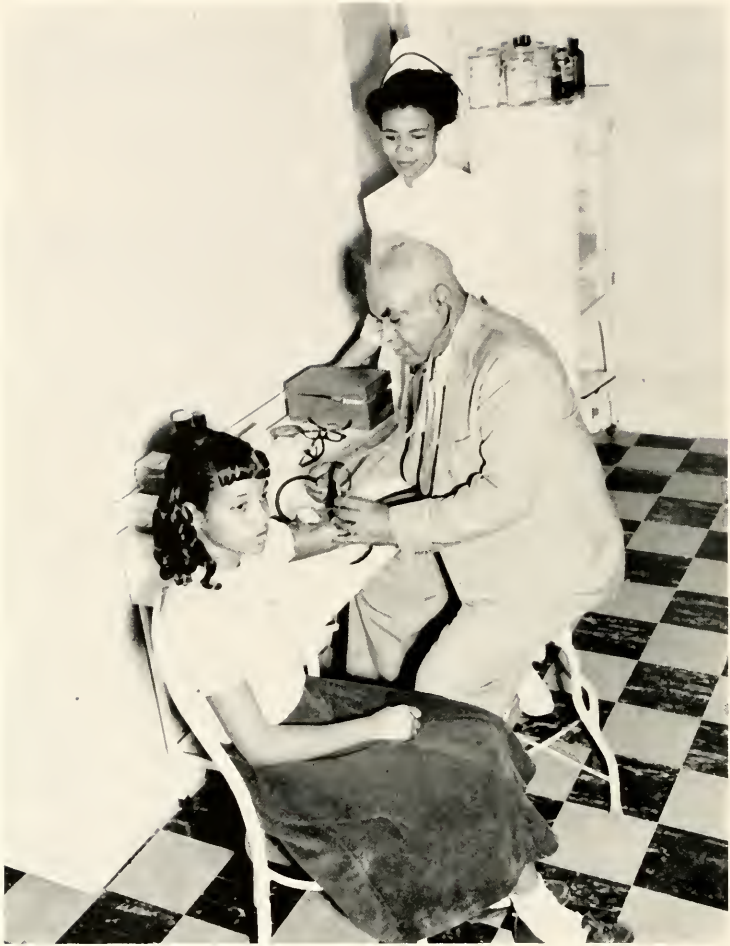

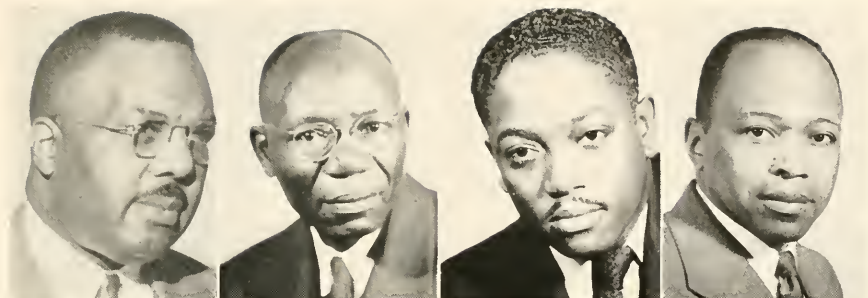
A MESSAGE
