FOREWORD

In this volume are presented eighty-five autograph plates containing one hundred and fifty-eight texts copied by Dr. Poebel between the spring of 1912 and the spring of 1914, during which time he was at work upon a selected series of tablets which had been assigned to him from the Babylonian collections of the Museum.

The title of the volume sufficiently indicates the character of the texts chosen for immediate publication. In Volume IV will be found transcriptions and translations of a portion of the historical texts, and in Volume VI will be found transcriptions and translations of a portion of the grammatical texts. It has been Dr. Poebel's purpose to continue these transcriptions and translations until all of these texts shall have been dealt with in the same manner. It is the plan of the Museum in the event of this purpose being realized to publish these additional translations as continuations of Volumes IV and VI.

In addition to the autograph plates, this volume contains forty photographic plates of tablets selected from the same series.

It is due to Dr. Poebel to state that he has had no opportunity of inspecting the plates in this volume.
