And of the Golden Rule.

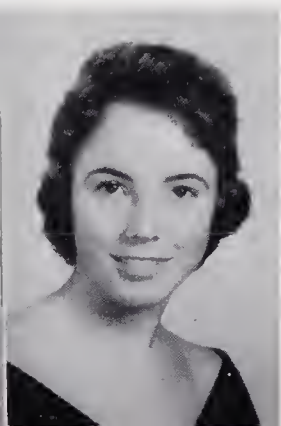
