Shrubs or Trees *must* be shipped by express.

Plants or Bulbs may be shipped by express collect, or if you prefer, add 10% to cover the cost of packing necessary and postage for parcel post prepaid to all points East of the Mississippi River. West of Mississippi, add 20% extra.

NOTICE

Regarding small lots of assorted plants or shrubs

One to four plants of one identical kind or color will be priced at the each rate, except in the case of Perennials and Rock Rarden Plants where the rate for three of the same kind is 60 cents.

This is necessary as each different kind or color has to be wrapped and labeled separately and considerable time is required to assemble an order made up of small lots of kinds that are widely separated over the nursery.
