We've strived to achieve--and achieve we have; Only now--- for each to go his separate way.

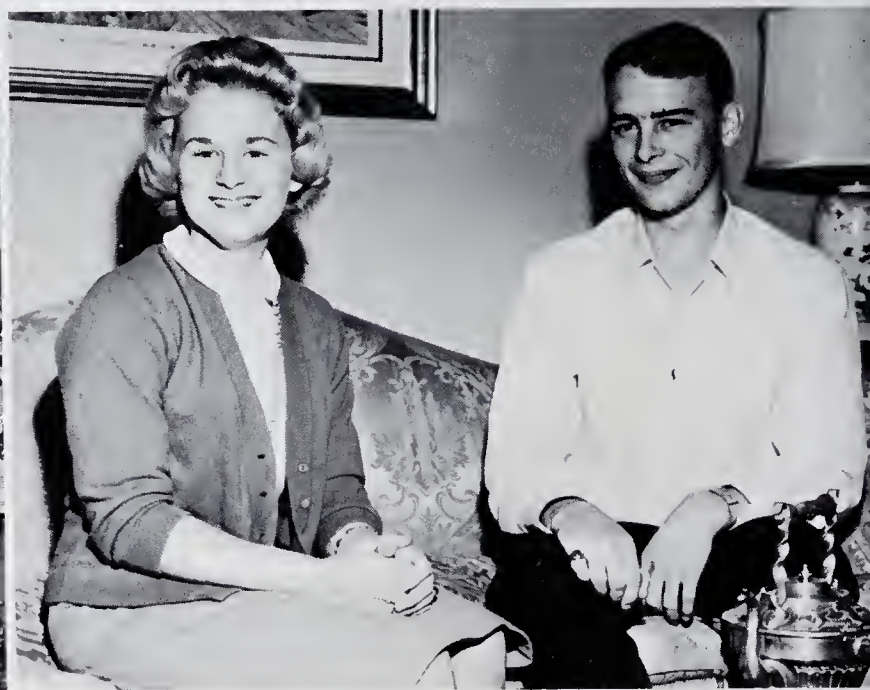
