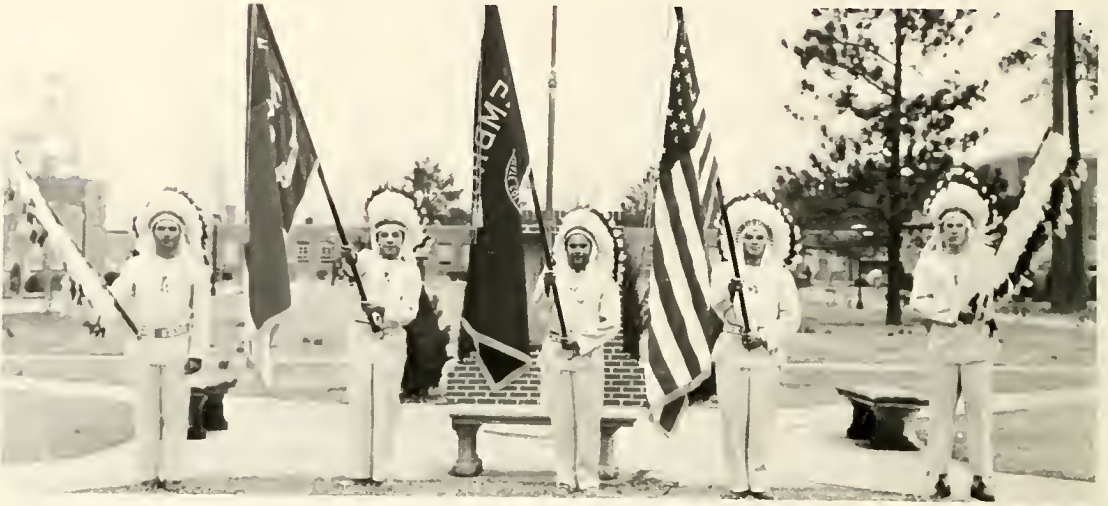

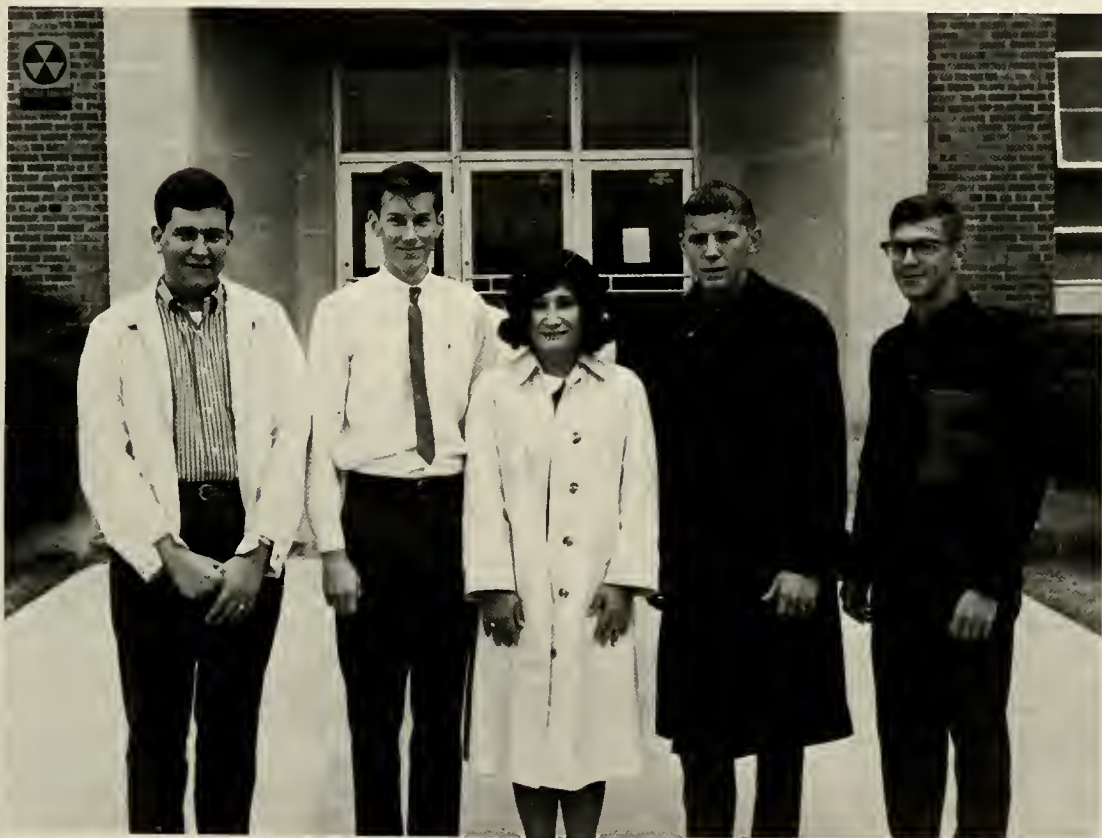
NATURAL SCIENCE CLUB

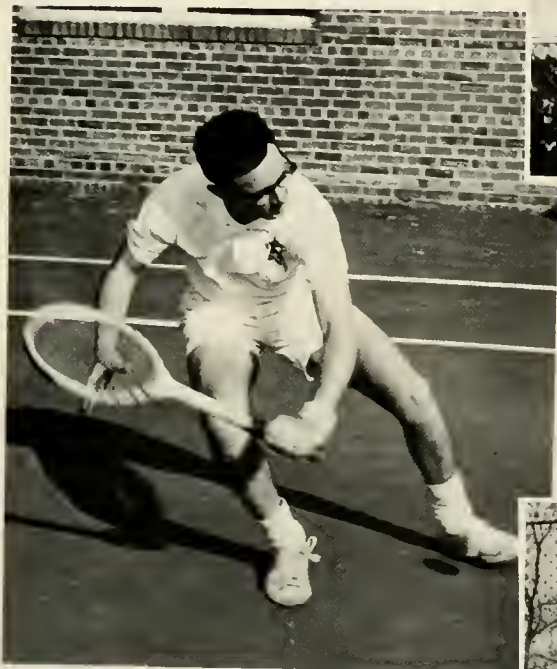
