The 1977 INDIANHEAD cites Dr. Robert W. Reising, professor of Communicative Arts since 1971, for his understanding — he knows what education is all about. Dr. Reising realizes that education is the combination of academics and learning about life. By exemplifying the best qualities of a professor, Dr. Reising has set a fine model for each of his students to live by.

Dr. Reising is a native of New Haven, Connecticut, and holds the B.A. degree with special honors in English from Michigan State, the M.A. in English from the University of Connecticut, and the Ed.D. in English Education from Duke University.

Prior to coming to PSU, Dr. Reising taught at the University of South Florida and Virginia Commonwealth University. He also compiled a 106-89 record as head baseball coach in nine years of intercollegiate athletics.

Dr. Reising has published over 35 articles in professional journals. He is author of Jim Thorpe: Tar Heel, and Jim Thorpe: The Story of an American Indian.

Currently, Dr. Reising serves as a member of the Nominating Committee of the Conference on English Education, as well as the Second Vice President of the North Carolina English Teachers Association.

Pembroke State University is fortunate to have such a brilliant professor in Dr. Reising. The students are united in hoping that he will be with us for many years to come.

The team, according to the coach, should be improved in all areas.

















Back to lead the team are All-Americans David Miller and Steve LaPrad. The other tri-captains will be Rick Liss, who was a District 19 champion last year.


PSU's Cross Country team had captured seven NAIA titles in the last eight years. A hard act to follow? Not for the Braves.



"We have possibilities now. This is the best team we've ever had — with more depth," said Coach Ann Webb.



Mrs. William Henry Belk

Dedication of Belk Hall

On October 27, 1976, South Hall dormitory on campus officially changed its name to the Mary Irwin Belk Hall, in honor of the late Mrs. William Henry Belk who died in 1968. The dedication of the building was made possible by the Belk family, who, recognizing Mrs. Belk's concern for education and for her many outstanding accomplishments, made a large donation to the Pembroke State University Foundation, Inc. She was graduated from what is now known as the Queen's College of Charlotte. After teaching in the Charlotte public schools, she married William Henry Belk in 1915. As president of the Queens College Alumnae Association and a member of the Board of Trustees of Queens College, she was presented with the Algernon Sydney Sullivan Award from Queens College in 1957. Although active for many years in various civic and historical organizations, her special interest lay in Crossnore School in the Blue Ridge Mountains where she aided the underpriviledged children in the mountain area. She was also interested in Presbyterian Home for Children in Barium Springs, and for many years she remained a member of the Board of Trustees of Alexander Home of Charlotte. Among her numerous historical organizations were included the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution and the Daughters of the American Colonists. She was also a member of the Daughters of 1812, Daughters of Colonial Wars, Barons of Runnemede, Order of Crown, Colonial Dames of America, United Daughters of the Confederacy, Mecklenburg Historical Society, Tryon Palace Commission Board of Trustees and National Officers Club, N.S.D.A.R.

At the offical ceremony, a portrait was presented of Mrs. William Henry Belk which now hangs in the lobby of Mary Irwin Belk Hall, a reminder to all of her vast achievements.
