






Above is the old snack bar in "A" building. Below the new Student Union, which was completed in January. Students rejoice, "We now have a place to sit down!"











The Learning Resource Center

The Learning Resource Center at Wayne Community College, which includes the traditional library, the media or audio-visual, the graphics and the directed studies areas, is a place of varied activities. Not only will you find books, periodicals and newspapers being used, but you will see students listening to professors' lectures on tapes or cassettes at individual study carrels, using filmstrips with a recording explaining how to write a term paper, working with programmed materials in many subject areas, and using microfilm readers which will also print any article they need.

A reclassification project was made possible, with federal funds, to reclassify the book collection by the Library of Congress System, and at present the reclassification team is working on non book and programmed materials.

The administration, staff, faculty, and students are working diligently to bring the book collection up to 20,000 volumes, which is the minimum requirement for an accredited two-year college. To date the number is approaching the 16,000 volume mark.

Sound on slide projectors are being purchased and will be used by several departments for independent study, and since this is a trend in education throughout the country we expect much use will be made of these projectors in the months ahead.

Materials have been added in the Directed Studies for all areas of study, including high school, vocational, technical, college transfer and general interest.

The staff of the Learning Resource Center and the Wayne County Public Library endeavor to evidence a joint effort of service to the community.
