Margie Cox-Will be touring the southern states with her dancing partner, Sam Tyson.

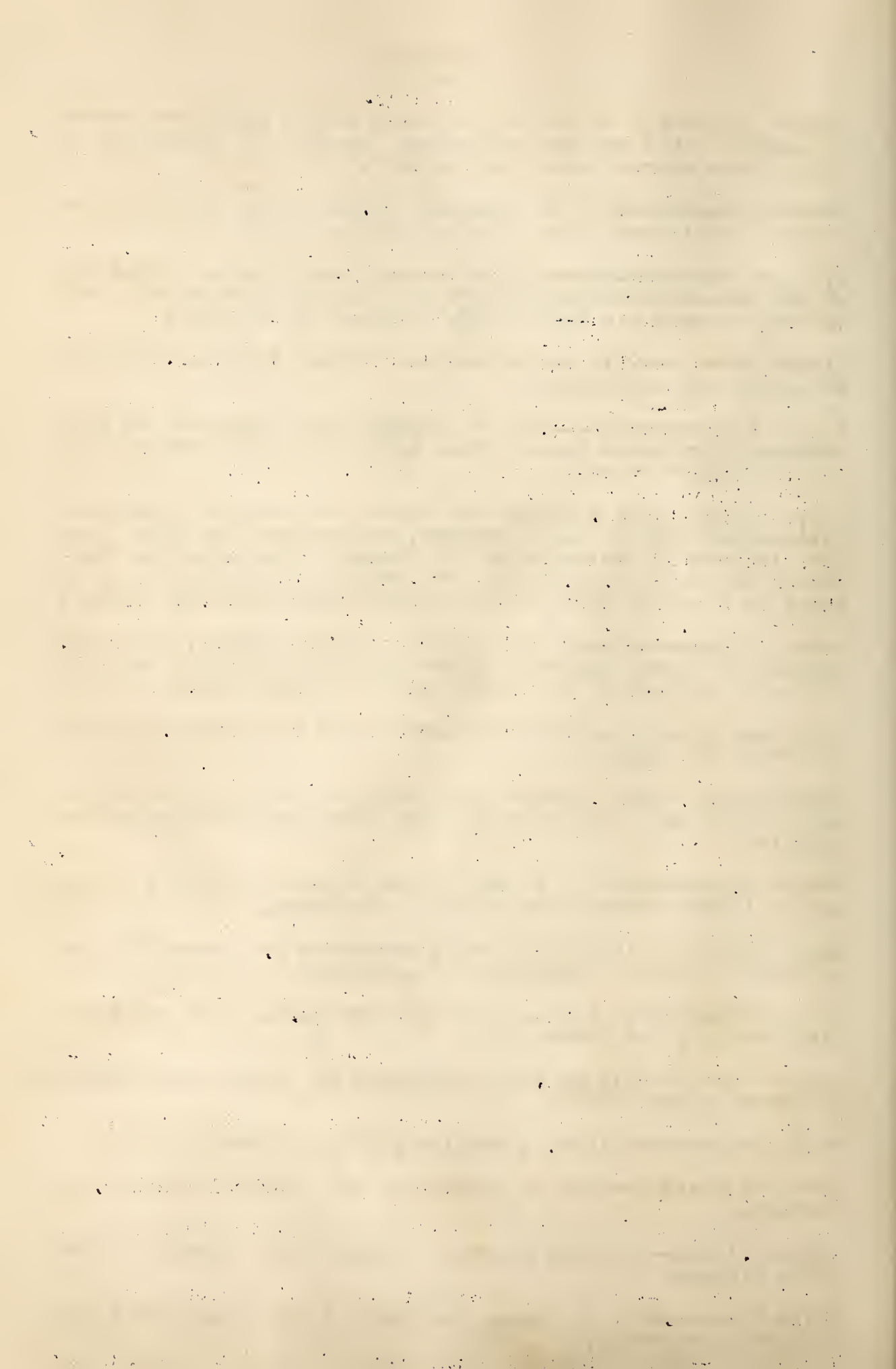
Lydia Herring--Will be the accompanist of Jessie Wetherington the great opera singer.

14th. Maurace Jones does give his guitar to Tull Jackson.

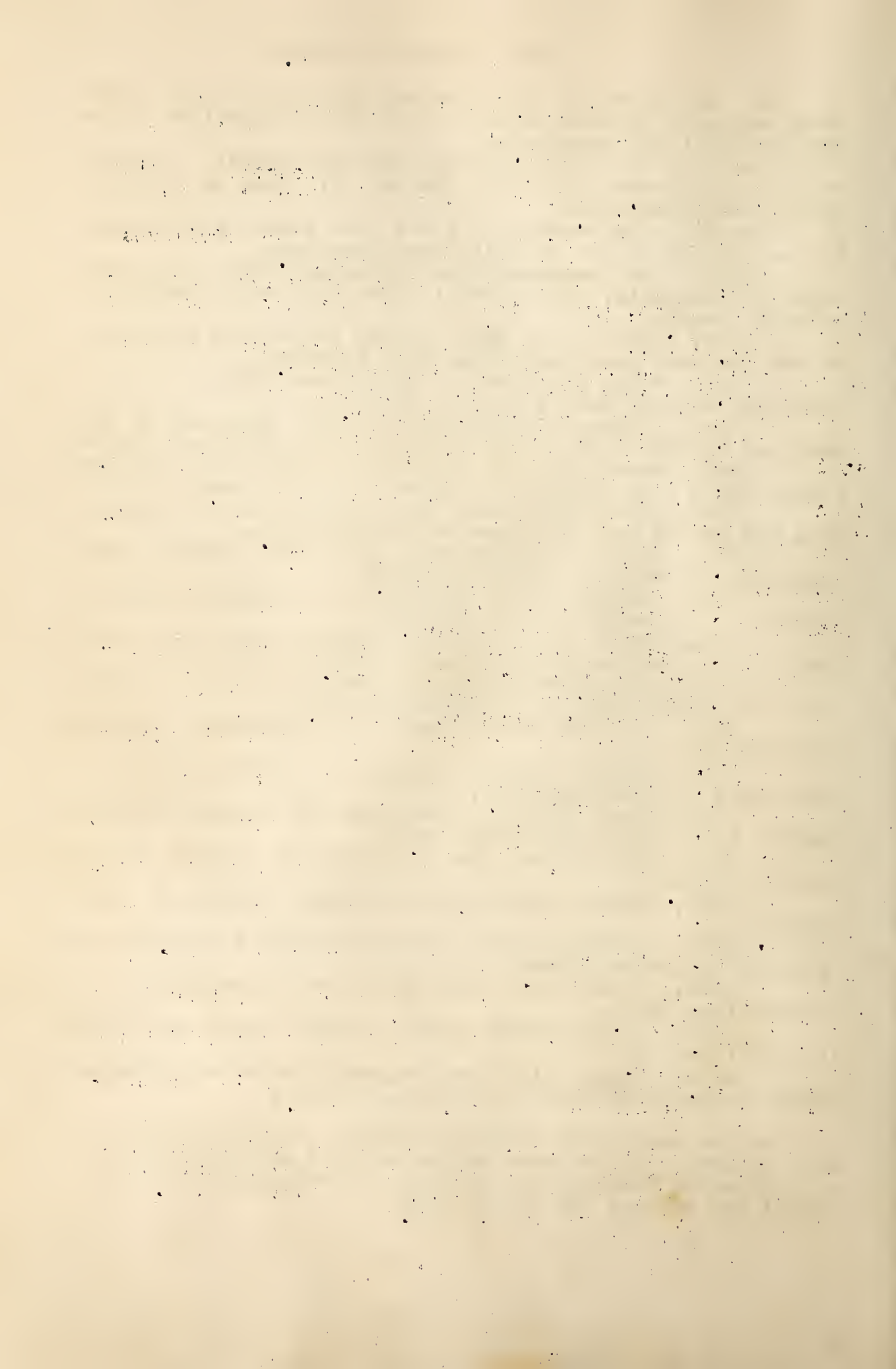
15th. Kathleen Tyndall does bequeath her ability to "giggle" to Louise Beaman.
