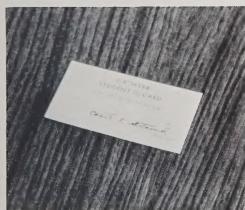
Emotions have been shown openly . . . tension being present to a certain degree. This problem having been met head-on, the students were able to conquer it and now peace prevails.

# DECA

It is a program of education which provides instruction for those entering or engaged in activities necessary to move products and services from the producer to the consumer.

This program combines part-time work experience with practical in-school instruction so that upon graduation students will be well qualified employees and useful citizens.

Through combined in-school instruction, on-the-job training, and careful supervision of trainees by the teacher-coordinator, the best qualities of the students are discovered and developed.

Students spend part of their time in school and part of their time on the job. In addition to required school subjects, they study basic subjects, such as salesmanship, merchandise information, business organization, economics of distribution, stock-keeping, color design, display, advertising and business law. In school boys and girls learn the "why" of their jobs so they will associate the functions of their present or future employment with the general business picture. Knowing the "why" they can tackle the "how" of jobs with more understanding and intelligence.

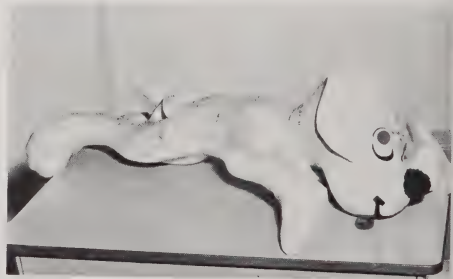

Feeder School Bus Drivers



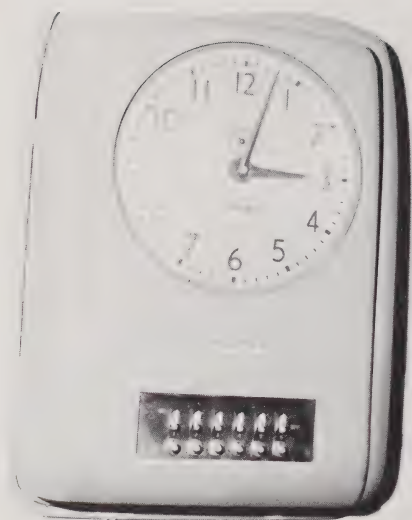
