During the month of March, the Spanish Club will have a Fiesta, which is the equivalent of the French Mardi Gras. All Spanish students are looking forward to this gala event.



In school boys and girls learn the "why" of their jobs so they will associate the functions of their present or future employment with the general business picture. Knowing the "why" they can tackle the "how" of jobs with more understanding and intelligence.
