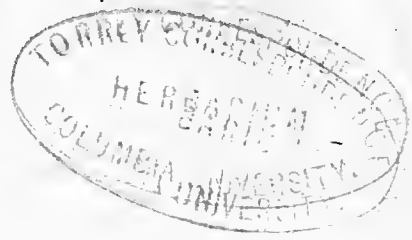
Dear Sir,

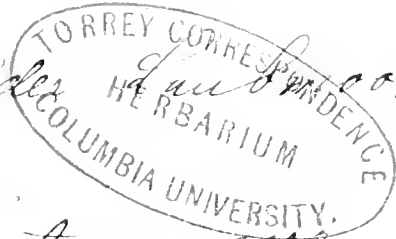
