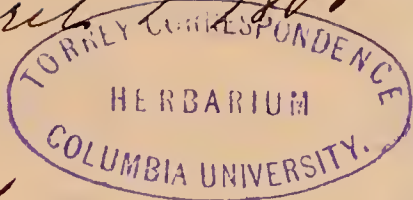


Recd March 19th
