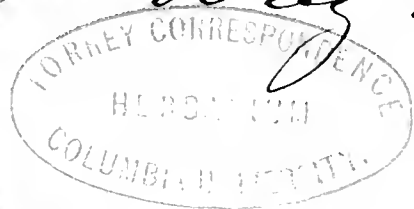

for Washington

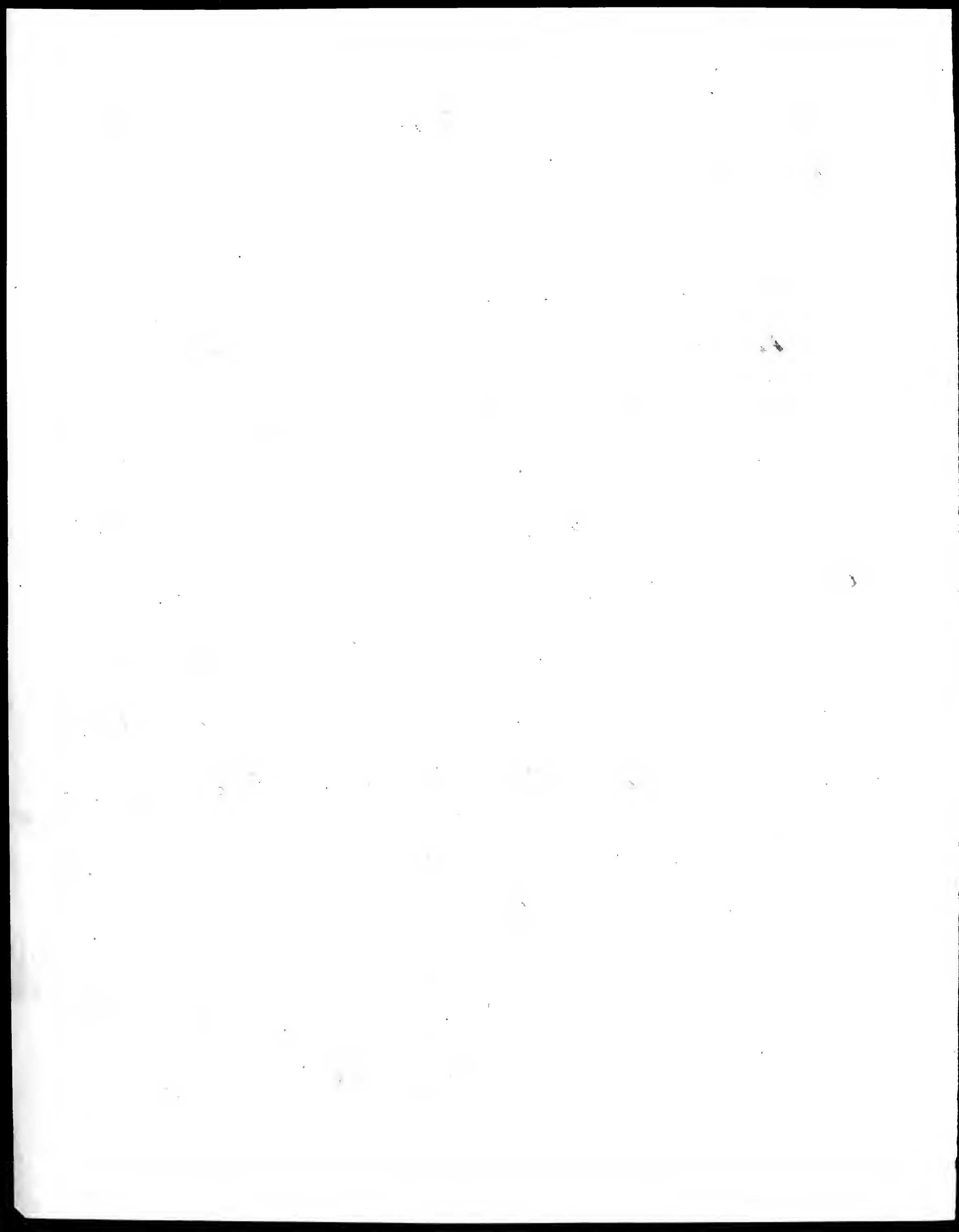
