BY-LAWS

ARTICLE 1. This Club shall be called the NUTTALL ORNITHOLOGICAL CLUB OF CAMBRIDGE.

ARTICLE 2. It shall consist of Resident, Corresponding, Honorary, and Foreign Honorary Members.

Resident Members shall be persons interested in ornithology who, at the time of their election, live in the vicinity of Cambridge, and shall alone be entitled to vote, to hold office, or to transact business. Every such person elected to resident membership shall, within three months from the date of his election, pay to the Treasurer an entrance fee of two dollars, and in writing agree to conform to the by-laws of the Club; until so doing he shall not be entitled to the rights of membership.

Corresponding Members shall be persons interested in ornithology who reside at a distance from Cambridge.

Honorary Members, not exceeding ten in number, shall be ornithologists of eminence who reside in the United States.

Foreign Honorary Members shall not exceed twenty in number, and shall be distinguished ornithologists who reside without the United States.

Corresponding, Honorary, and Foreign Honorary Members may attend meetings and take part in the scientific discussions of the Club; they shall not be liable for dues.

ARTICLE 3. The officers of the Club shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, who together with five other members of the Club shall constitute the Council, of which the Secretary shall be clerk ex officio.

The Secretary shall keep a true record of the proceedings at all meetings of the Club and of the Council. He shall give written notice of all such meetings to members entitled thereto, and shall perform such other duties as pertain to his office.

The Treasurer shall have charge of all securities of the Club; shall collect all fees and assessments; shall pay all bills against the Club, authorized by a vote of the Council; shall keep a correct account of all receipts and expenditures; and shall make a detailed report at the annual meeting.

The Council shall manage the affairs, and superintend all publications, of the Club. Four members thereof shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

ARTICLE 4. Members of the Club shall be elected by the Council at a meeting called for that purpose. Two adverse votes shall exclude. The name of a candidate shall be first proposed by a Resident Member at a meeting of the Club.

ARTICLE 5. The officers and the five members of the Club, who together with them constitute the Council, shall be chosen by ballot at the first regular meeting of the Club in December of each year, which shall be the annual meeting, upon nominations made at a preceding meeting, and shall hold office for the ensuing year, or until others shall be chosen in their stead. A three-fourths vote of the Resident Members present shall elect. Any vacancy occurring after the annual meeting, shall be filled for the balance of the term by election at any subsequent meeting of the Club, a majority of the members present being sufficient to elect. Pending such election, the President, or in his absence the Vice-President, may fill the vacancy temporarily by appointment.

ARTICLE 6. Any member may withdraw from the Club, by giving to the Secretary written notice of his intention to do so, upon payment of all existing indebtedness.

The name of any member whose dues remain unpaid thirteen months shall be erased from the roll.

Any member may be expelled from the Club by a vote of three fourths of the members present at a meeting specially called for that purpose, a written notice having been sent to each Resident Member at least one month previous to the date thereof.

ARTICLE 7. Every Resident Member shall be subject to annual dues of two dollars, payable at the annual meeting. One half the first annual dues shall be remitted to new members elected after June first. The Council may, by a three-fourths vote, exempt any member from the payment of dues for any year. Commutation of annual dues may be purchased for twenty-five dollars.

ARTICLE 8. Regular meetings of the Club shall be held on the first and third Monday evenings of each month, from October first to June fifteenth inclusive, unless suspended by vote of the Club. By the written request of the President, or of five Resident Members, the Secretary may be required to call a special meeting, giving five days' notice of the same. Five Resident Members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

All meetings of the Council shall be called by the Secretary, upon request of the President or of three of its members, three days' notice of such meetings being given to each of its members.

ARTICLE 9. The By-Laws of the Club may be altered or

amended by a three-fourths vote of the Resident Members present at any regular meeting. Notice of a proposed change in the By-Laws of the Club must be given at a regular meeting. Any action must be taken at a subsequent regular meeting, notice of a proposed change having been first sent to all Resident Members at least five days previously. A three-fourths vote shall be necessary for the adoption of the change
