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sketches of plants in watercolor, — of these he painted several hundred, many of which, in addition to his drawings of fungi, are now in this Museum.

Becoming interested in mushrooms in the late nineties, probably to a large extent through their coloring, and realizing the perishable nature and unsatisfactory character of preserved specimens of these plants, he devoted his spare time during the warmer months for the remainder of his life very largely to collecting, studying, and delineating them with artistic effectiveness and scientific precision; and with such diligence did he work that about 1100 portraits of the fleshy fungi remain for the benefit of posterity. These drawings form the subject of this List.

Mr. Morris discovered numerous new species in the course of his study, four of which were named in his honor, one each in the genera **Amanita**, **Boletus**, **Cortinarius**, and **Hygrophorus**. Though a critical student and knowing well the scientific worth of his finds, it was his modest practice, on the ground that he was not a professional botanist, to refer his discoveries for technical description and publication to Professor Charles H. Peck, of Albany, New York. Undoubtedly, previous to Mr. Morris' death, nearly all of his drawings of mushrooms were examined by this authority.

The scene of Mr. Morris' activity naturally lay chiefly in Waltham and its immediate vicinity, comprising the suburbs of Boston for about twenty miles on the south and west (Cohasset, Ellis, Sherborn, Saxonville, Stow) and extending to Lynn, Gloucester, Ipswich, and Amesbury on the north. His knowledge of the mushroom flora of this district was probably surpassed by none. For nearly twenty years his week-ends during the open season were largely



spent in study of it, and his acquaintance with the most productive localities was intimate. In the summer vacations he frequently collected at Friendship, Maine, the vicinity of Mt. Chocorua, New Hampshire, and Syracuse, New York.

Mr. Morris' drawings are for the most part on sheets of paper ten by thirteen inches in size, with a small number six and a half by nine inches. Each sheet contains one or more drawings in color, natural size, of the mushroom, often in several stages and sometimes a whole cluster; a longitudinal section in color, natural size; usually the spores in pencil outline, sometimes with structure and sculpture indicated; and occasionally additional details, color after fracture, (e. g., in **Boletus**), etc. A large number of spore prints and many dried specimens are also comprised in the collection.

The drawings are arranged and listed alphabetically by genera and species, for convenience of consultation. When no locality is stated, it is believed that the specimen was usually (but not invariably) obtained in Waltham or its vicinity. Under the species the drawings are arranged as follows: 1st, those without data; 2d, those with dates only; 3d, alphabetically from localities in eastern Massachusetts; 4th, alphabetically from other States; and last, undetermined species of the genus in the same sequence. The number of the latter awaiting determination after fuller study is sufficient evidence of the richness of the field, the difficulties and the opportunities awaiting the systematist.

It is the wish of the heirs of Mr. Morris and the trustees of the Museum to make the results of his labors as fully available as possible to students of this group of plants; and all such are urged to visit the Museum and study for

themselves the data provided by the drawings and collections. This List has been prepared in accordance with this purpose and as a slight record and memorial of Mr. Morris' work in the field of science.

The frontispiece portrait is from a photograph taken, it is believed, about twenty years ago.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS. — The names of the authors of the species often were not stated on the drawings. For this List they have been secured, either directly or through friends, for the most part from the more readily available literature; a number of the less accessible ones, however, most kindly have been supplied by Professor Wm. G. Farlow of Cambridge, to whom thanks are due for a favor which is highly appreciated. I wish to thank also all who have aided in the preparation of the List in any way, and particularly to acknowledge my indebtedness to Mrs. Eliza B. Blackford, Miss Jennie M. Conant, and Mr. Hollis Webster, all of the Boston Mycological Club; and Professor Lincoln W. Riddle of Wellesley College.
