As a class project we had charge of the concession stand at the basketball games.

For high achievement, outstanding leadership and noble character eight members of our junior class were inducted into the National Beta Club. They were Mary Esther Biles, Peggy Pickler, Earlene Smith, Priscilla Smith, Mildred Miller, Gerald Smith, Gary Frick, and Lewis Burris. W. C. Flake, representing our class, was crowned Halloween King.

Some of the highlights of our senior year were receiving our class rings, presenting the Senior Play, "China Boy", the Junior-Senior Banquet, and the publication of our annual, THE LONDONER.

As graduation comes and we leave our alma mater, we are thankful for the help, influence, and friendship that Mr. Turner, the faculty, and the students have given us. These will be remembered by us, the Class of 1957, forever.
